

The petition is dismissed for lack of jurisdiction because the Petitioners have failed to cite an independent basis that would allow the Court to exercise its all writs authority and no such basis is apparent on the face of the petition. *See Williams v. State*, 913 So. 2d 541, 543-44 (Fla. 2005); *St. Paul Title Ins. Corp. v. Davis*, 392 So. 2d 1304, 1305 (Fla. 1980).
