#### FINAL ORDER

This matter came before the Commission on Ethics, meeting in public session on December 11, 2015, on the appeal of Colleen Conklin-Walsh, pursuant to Section 112.3145(7)(f), Florida Statutes, which assesses an automatic fine of \$25 per day against a person who fails to timely file a required CE Form 6, Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interest. The Commission may waive the fine in whole or in part for good cause shown, based on "unusual circumstances" surrounding the failure to file by the designated due date. There are no material facts in dispute. Appellant did not specifically request a hearing before the Commission.

#### **Findings of Fact**

- 1. During the year 2013, Appellant served on the Flagler County School Board, a position that required the annual filing of financial disclosure. She was late in filing a required CE Form 6, Full and Public Disclosure of Financial Interest, for the year 2013. The designated date for submitting a 2013 CE Form 6 annual filing was July 1, 2014, with a grace period ending on September 2, 2014.
- 2. On May 15, 2014, the Commission mailed Appellant a CE Form 6. This mailing was sent to 229 Ocean Palm Drive, Flagler Beach Florida 32136.

- 3. On July 31, 2014, the Commission mailed Appellant a Notice of Delinquency. This mailing was sent certified to the 229 Ocean Palm Drive address, and signed for on August 2, 2014, by a person who used only initials.
- 4. On August 14, 2014, the Commission mailed Appellant a postcard intended to remind her of the obligation to file CE Form 6. The Commission mailed this postcard to the 229 Ocean Palm Drive address.
- 5. On September 4, 2014, the Commission mailed Appellant a letter to inform her that an automatic fine had begun to accrue. The Commission mailed this letter to the 229 Ocean Palm Drive address.
- 6. On October 10, 2014, the Appellant called the Commission, stating that she gave her financial disclosure form to her husband to mail, but he lost it or threw it out while cleaning his truck. A Commission staff member advised Appellant to complete and send a new form as soon as possible, because automatic fines were accruing.
- 7. On December 1, 2014, the Commission mailed Appellant a Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine. This mailing included, for the first time, the total of Appellant's accrued automatic fine. The mailing also included a notice of Appellant's right to appeal the fine. The Commission sent this mailing certified to the 229 Ocean Palm Drive address, and it was returned as unclaimed.
  - 8. The amount of the fine automatically assessed against Appellant was \$1,500.
- 9. On March 25, 2015, the Commission mailed a second copy of the Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine, including the notice of Appellant's right to appeal the fine. This mailing was sent to the 229 Ocean Palm Drive address.

- 10. On April 22, 2015, Appellant submitted her appeal, and a copy of 2013 CE Form 6, by facsimile. This form is hand-written, dated July 1, 2014, and notarized by Kristy Gavin.
- 11. On May 13, 2015, a Commission staff member left Appellant a voicemail, indicating that the Commission received the appeal, but filing is not complete until the Commission receives an original, signed and notarized 2013 CE Form 6.
- 12. On June 16, 2015, a Commission staff member left a voicemail for Appellant, indicating that the appeal could not be processed unless the Commission receives an original, signed and notarized 2013 CE Form 6.
- 13. On June 19, 2015, a Commission staff member returned a call to Kristy Gavin, who called on Appellant's behalf. Commission staff advised that the appeal could not be processed unless the Commission received an original, signed and notarized 2013 CE Form 6.
- 14. On June 22, 2015, Kristy Gavin called the Commission, stated that Appellant mailed 2013 CE Form 6 in July 2014, but failed to keep a copy for herself, so she completed a new Form 6 and sent it with her appeal. A Commission staff member advised that Form 6 must be signed in ink, and notarized.
- 15. On June 29, 2015, Appellant filed a signed and notarized 2013 CE Form 6 with the Commission. This form is typed, dated July 1, 2014, and notarized by Kristy Gavin.
- 16. In support of her appeal, Appellant provided an affidavit, notarized by Kristy Gavin, in which Appellant states that she is aware of the mandatory reporting requirement and has submitted annual forms since joining the school board in 2000. To support a claim of timely filing, Appellant states she completed 2013 CE Form 6 prior to the filing deadline and gave it to her husband to mail. Appellant states she realized her husband had not mailed 2013 CE Form 6 on or about August 2, 2014, when she received a delinquency notice from the Commission. In the appeal

form, Appellant states "the form was not submitted until on or about Sept. 1, 2014." In an attached affidavit, Appellant states that 2013 CE Form 6 was mailed to the Commission "on or about September 2, 2014," and added: "I did not submit a penalty check with the submission as this was the last day of the grace period."

- 17. Appellant states she believed 2013 CE Form 6 had been timely filed because she had no further communications until she received a March 25, 2015 notice about the assessment of fines.
- 18. As additional support for her appeal, Appellant attached an affidavit of her husband, Christopher Conklin, which is notarized by Kristy Gavin. Appellant's husband states that he thought he sent the envelope as his wife requested, but actually misplaced the mail in his car. He states he found 2013 CE Form 6 in late August, and returned it to his wife, who mailed the envelope to the Commission on or about September 2, 2014.

#### **Conclusions of Law**

- 19. The Commission has jurisdiction over Appellant and over the subject matter of this proceeding pursuant to Section 112.3144, Florida Statutes.
- 20. Financial disclosure is required of public officials and employees because it enables the public to evaluate potential conflicts of interest, deters corruption, and increases public confidence in government. In order to increase compliance, beginning in 2001, the Legislature provided for an automatic fine of \$25 per day, up to a cap of \$1,500, on persons who do not timely file their financial disclosure statements. Under the law, the Legislature permitted the Commission to waive a fine only "based upon unusual circumstances surrounding the failure to file on the designated due date . . . ."

21. Commission Rule 34-8.215, F.A.C., defines "unusual circumstances" as follows:

uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control and which directly result in the failure to act in accordance with the filing requirement. Circumstances which allow for time in which to take those steps necessary to assure compliance with the filing requirement shall be deemed not to constitute unusual circumstances.

22. The Commission finds that Appellant did file 2013 CE Form 6 on June 29, 2015, which is one year after the July 1, 2014 deadline, or nearly 10 months after the grace period for late filing elapsed. Appellant submitted a sworn statement in which she states she mailed her disclosure form, which had been misplaced for a time, on or about either September 1, 2014, or September 2, 2014. Appellant further states she had no indication that the form had not been filed until she received the March 25, 2015 Notice of Assessment of Automatic Fine. This explanation does not constitute an "unusual circumstance" that justifies waiving the fine, because Appellant spoke with a Commission staff member on October 10, 2014, when Appellant was advised that automatic fines were accruing because 2013 CE Form 6 had not been received. Appellant timely filed her appeal, but still had not filed an original, signed, and notarized 2013 CE Form 6. Additionally, Kristy Gavin, who called the Commission on Appellant's behalf, stated that the Appellant mailed the original 2013 CE Form 6 in July 2014, but did not keep a copy for herself. Nevertheless, both forms provided by the Appellant – a hand-written copy that was faxed on April 22, 2015, and a typed original that was received by mail on June 29, 2015 – are dated July 1, 2014 and notarized by Kristy Gavin. The mailing mix-up described by the Appellant and the Appellant's husband is understandable, but the Appellant had time to cure this deficiency, and did not do so until she received three additional calls from the Commission, advising that the filing remained delinquent. Appellant's explanations are not "uncommon, rare or sudden events over which the reporting individual has no control," and therefore they do not constitute "unusual circumstances" that justify waiving the \$1,500 fine.

#### Order

Based on the foregoing facts and conclusions of law, the Commission hereby affirms the assessed fine of \$1,500 and denies the appeal. The fine shall be paid to the Commission on Ethics, P. O. Drawer 15709, Tallahassee, FL 32317-5709, within 30 days of the date this order is rendered unless other payment arrangements are made by contacting Kimberly Holmes, Financial Disclosure Coordinator, telephone 850-488-7864.

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
