A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM COAST, FLORIDA, APPROVING A CONTRACT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$360,376.00, FOR A LEVEL II CUSTOM PUMPER FIRE APPARATUS FROM ROSENBAUER SOUTH DAKOTA, LLC; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE SAID CONTRACT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTING ACTIONS AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC has agreed to provide a Level II Custom Pumper to the City of Palm Coast; and

WHEREAS, the City of Palm Coast desires to purchase a Level II Custom Pumper Fire Apparatus from Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC; and

WHEREAS, City Council desires to enter into a Contract with Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC for a Level II Custom Pumper Fire Apparatus.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PALM COAST, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. APPROVAL OF CONTRACT. The City Council of the City of Palm Coast hereby approves the purchase of a Level II Custom Pumper, in the amount of \$360,376.00, from Rosenbauer South Dakota, LLC, as attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as Exhibit "A."

SECTION 2. AUTHORIZATION TO EXECUTE. The City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute the necessary documents.

SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any section or portion of a section of this Resolution proves to be invalid, unlawful, or unconstitutional, it shall not be held to invalidate or impair the validity, force, or effect of any other section or part of this Resolution.

SECTION 4. CONFLICTS. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict with any of the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. IMPLEMENTING ACTIONS. The City Manager is hereby authorized to take any actions necessary to implement the action taken in this Resolution.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Council.
