**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE**

Plaintiff was in custody at the Flagler County Detention Facility when he filed this civil rights case on about May 1, 2017. On the Civil Rights Complaint form completed by Plaintiff, he was advised that his failure to keep a current address on file with the Clerk's Office may result in the dismissal of his case. The Court has mailed two documents to Plaintiff since he filed this case, both of which have been returned to the Court as undeliverable because Plaintiff was released from custody on May 9, 2017. There is no forwarding address available, and Plaintiff has not filed anything with the Court since he filed the Complaint.

Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED:**

1. This case is **DISMISSED without prejudice** for Plaintiff's failure to prosecute.

2. The Clerk shall enter judgment dismissing this case without prejudice, terminate any pending motions, and close the file.
