Fence Update

 At their March 10th workshop, Council directed staff to bring back more data on possibly allowing fences in front yards and stepping the fence down along saltwater canals.



• Planning staff suggests the following criteria if fences are permitted in the front yard:





Permitted as Landscape feature







Front yard could not be enclosed with a fence – only permitted within front <u>side</u> setback.





- Maximum height of 3 feet
- o Fences must be open with at least 50% opacity
- No chain link fences allowed
- o Setback at least 5 feet from front property line.





Front Yard Fence Limits

- Staff suggests front yard fences be limited:
 - o Permitted as Landscape feature
 - Permitted only within front <u>side</u> setback.
 - oSetback at least 5 feet from front property line.
 - No chain link fences allowed
 - o Maximum height of 3 feet
 - o Fences must be open with at least 50% opacity

Fences in Saltwater Canal Backyards

Allow solid fences reduced 4 feet in height within 20' rear setback of a saltwater canal





Fences in Saltwater Canal Backyards

Allow solid fences reduced 4 feet in height within 20' rear setback of a saltwater canal





Fences in Saltwater Canal Backyards

Continue to allow 6 foot open fences within 20' rear setback of a saltwater canal





Fences in Saltwater Canal Backyards Recommendation

- Within 20' of a saltwater canal.
 - Solid fences reduced to four feet in height, or
 - Six foot high open fence
