Date: September 1st, 2022

According to Article V. of the City of Flagler Beach Charter as well as Florida Statute Chapter 200 of the Truth in Millage Act (TRIM), we have now completed the process of formulating the Fiscal Year 22/23 Budget for the City. Based on decisions made by the Commission, I am prepared to recommend that the Commission adopt a final millage rate of **5.45** and adopt the final budget for the City including the General Fund, Enterprise Funds, and the CRA as discussed with the Commission in our budget workshops.

I would like to thank the Commission and Department Heads for all of the time and energy that you have placed into the budget process. It is my assessment that should you pass the budget as recommended, several of the critical strategic objectives of the Commission will be realized in Fiscal Year 22/23. Listed below is a brief summary of what our team would consider as key budget highlights that should be accomplished in the coming year with the fiscal resources that you have allocated.

Major Projects/New Budget Items for FY 22/23:

- Employee pay raises to remain competitive and retain City talent
- Award Business Mini-grant Program/CRA Small-business Grants
- New Lighting in Downtown & Holiday Christmas Tree
- New Police Officer in Downtown (CRA)
- New Communications App for the City
- Additional Stormwater Projects & Compliance Measures
- Initiating Engineering Design for the Flagler Beach Fishing Pier
- New Fuel Depot Upgrades
- Initiation of new Wastewater Treatment Rebuild & Plant Upgrades
- Completion of a new Hydraulic Model for Wastewater Transmission System
- Inflow and Infiltration Reduction Program

- Fiber Optic Project Implementation
- Initiation of the Comprehensive Resiliency Initiative
- Dune Protection Programs
- Technology Upgrades- Drone/GIS-Mapping software
- Seed Funding for 2025 Centennial Celebration

Wrap-up for 21/22 Major Projects

- Completion of Pal Parker Park
- Completion of Funky Pelican Dumpster Pad
- Completion of Citywide Water Meter Installation

The proposed budget includes all of the necessary expenditures to operate the City for the next fiscal year and to the extent possible, provides estimated resources to mitigate inflationary factors in the economy. I believe that we have done so by imposing reasonable and limited cost increases where these investments are most needed.

RESOLUTION 2022-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF FLAGLER BEACH, FLORIDA LEVYING THE AD VALOREM PROPERTY TAX MILLAGE RATE FOR MUNICIPAL PURPOSES ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2022 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2023, STATING THE MILLAGE TO BE LEVIED IS 5.4500 IN FLAGLER COUNTY AND 5.4500 IS THE RATE TO BE LEVIED FOR VOLUSIA COUNTY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Florida law requires the City Commission of the City of Flagler Beach, Flagler/Volusia County, Florida, to pass an ordinance or resolution levying the millage rate for ad valorem property taxes for municipal purposes on all taxable property within the City limits of the City of Flagler Beach, Florida, for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023 and

WHEREAS, Florida law requires said ordinance or resolution to state the millage rate to be levied, and also, to state the percentage by which the millage rate to be levied exceeds the rolled-back rate as computed pursuant to Florida law; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Flagler Beach, Florida, has duly considered the budgetary requirements of the City; has adopted a tentative budget for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022 and ending September 30, 2023 based on a millage rate of **5.4500 mills for Flagler County and 5.4500 mills for Volusia County** on the taxable property within the City; and has acted in accordance with the terms, provisions, and procedures contained in Section 200.065, Florida Statutes;

WHEREAS, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Flagler County has been certified by the Flagler County Property Appraiser to the City of Flagler Beach as \$945,308,438. The gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Volusia County has been certified by the Volusia County Property Appraiser to the City of Flagler Beach as \$11,370,568.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the City Commission of the City of Flagler Beach, Florida, in special session assembled, that:

SECTION 1. The ad valorem property tax millage rate for municipal purposes to be levied on the taxable property within the City limits of the City of Flagler Beach, Florida, during the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2022, and ending September 30, 2023, is hereby set at the rate of **5.4500 mills for Flagler County and 5.4500 mills for Volusia County**.

SECTION 2. The Fiscal Year 2022-2023 operating millage rate is **5.4500 mills**, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 4.8242 mills by 12.97% for Flagler County. The Fiscal Year 2022-23 operating millage rate is **5.4500 mills**, which is greater than the rolled back rate of 4.8242 mills by 12.97% for Volusia County.
