


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Florida's December Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in December 2024, unchanged from the November 2024 rate, and up 0.3 percentage point from a year ago. There were 377,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,008,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in December.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 10,013,700 in December 2024, an increase of 18,000 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 147,900 jobs over the year, an increase of 1.5 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.4 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Eight of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in December.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+30,900 jobs, +2.1 percent); leisure and hospitality (+29,500 jobs, +2.3 percent); construction (+28,900 jobs, +4.5 percent); total government (+25,100 jobs, +2.2 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+21,200 jobs, +1.1 percent); other services (+18,400 jobs, +4.9 percent); professional and business services (+3,000 jobs, +0.2 percent); and information (+2,200 jobs, +1.4 percent).

- Leisure and hospitality gained 3,100 jobs over the month, the second consecutive month of job gains. The subsector contributing to most of the gain over the month was accommodation and food services which gained 2,200 jobs.
- Professional and technical services added 500 jobs in December, the first increase in this sector since August 2024. Employment in professional and technical services remains 9,500 jobs below the level from one year ago.
- Management of companies and enterprises added 200 jobs in December, the third consecutive over-themonth increase in this sector. Employment in management of companies and enterprises remains down 4,100 jobs from one year ago.
- The industries losing jobs over the year were manufacturing (-6,300 jobs, -1.5 percent) and financial activities (-4,900 jobs, -0.7 percent).
- Manufacturing lost 900 jobs over the month in December 2024, mainly in durable goods manufacturing which lost 700 jobs over the month. Manufacturing has lost jobs in 8 of the 12 months in 2024.

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2024, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (1.9 percent), followed by Miami-Dade County (2.5 percent), and Gulf, Nassau, Okaloosa, Seminole, St. Johns, and Wakulla Counties at (2.8 percent each).
- Citrus County had the highest unemployment rate (4.8 percent) in Florida in December 2024, followed by Hamilton County (4.6 percent), and Highlands County (4.5 percent).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2024, all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater MSA (+17,600 jobs, +1.1 percent), followed by the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+16,100 jobs, +1.2 percent), and the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+16,000 jobs, +1.1 percent).
- The North Port-Sarasota-Bradenton MSA remains 1,100 jobs below the pre-hurricane level from September 2024.

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
