

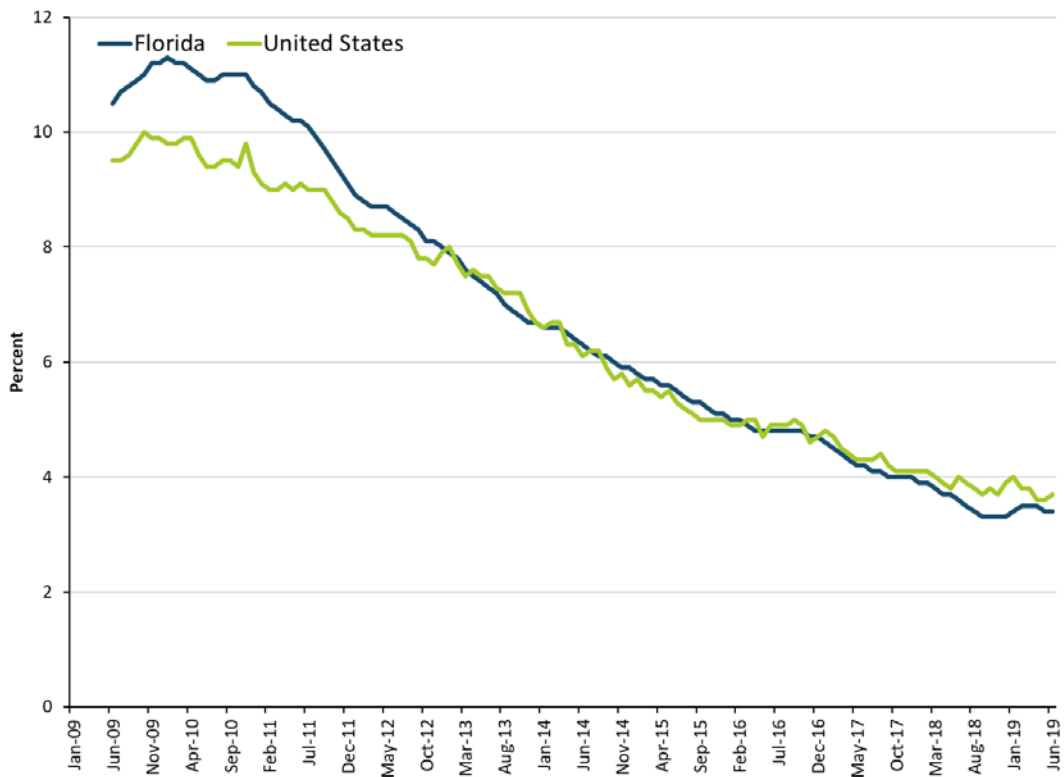
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Florida's June Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.4 percent in June 2019, unchanged from the May 2019 rate, and down 0.2 percentage point from a year ago. There were 349,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,338,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 3.7 percent in June.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,986,500 in June 2019, an increase of 16,100 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 218,800 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.5 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.5 percent over the year. With the exception of September 2017, Florida's over-the-year job growth rate has exceeded the nation's rate since April 2012.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,986,500 in June 2019, up 218,800 jobs compared to a year ago. The industry gaining the most jobs was education and health services (+54,700 jobs, +4.2 percent).

Other industries gaining jobs over the year included professional and business services (+40,500 jobs, +3.0 percent); leisure and hospitality (+31,200 jobs, +2.6 percent); construction (+25,800 jobs, +4.8 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+18,800 jobs, +1.1 percent); financial activities (+17,400 jobs, +3.0 percent); manufacturing (+10,500 jobs, +2.8 percent); government (+10,200 jobs, +0.9 percent); and other services (+9,600 jobs, +2.7 percent).

- The one industry losing jobs was information (-500 jobs, -0.4 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In June 2019, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.4 percent), followed by St. Johns County and Okaloosa County (2.9 percent each), Walton County (3.0 percent), and Orange County (3.1 percent).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (6.6 percent) in Florida in June 2019, followed by Hardee County (5.9 percent), Citrus County and Sumter County (5.2 percent), and Highlands County (5.1 percent).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In June 2019, 22 out of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+48,600 jobs, +3.8 percent), Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+29,300 jobs, +2.2 percent), and Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (+24,900 jobs, +2.1 percent).
- One metro area in Florida experienced an over-the-year job loss in June 2019, Panama City (-2,400 jobs, -2.7 percent).
- The Sebring metro area did not register any over-the-year job gains.

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
