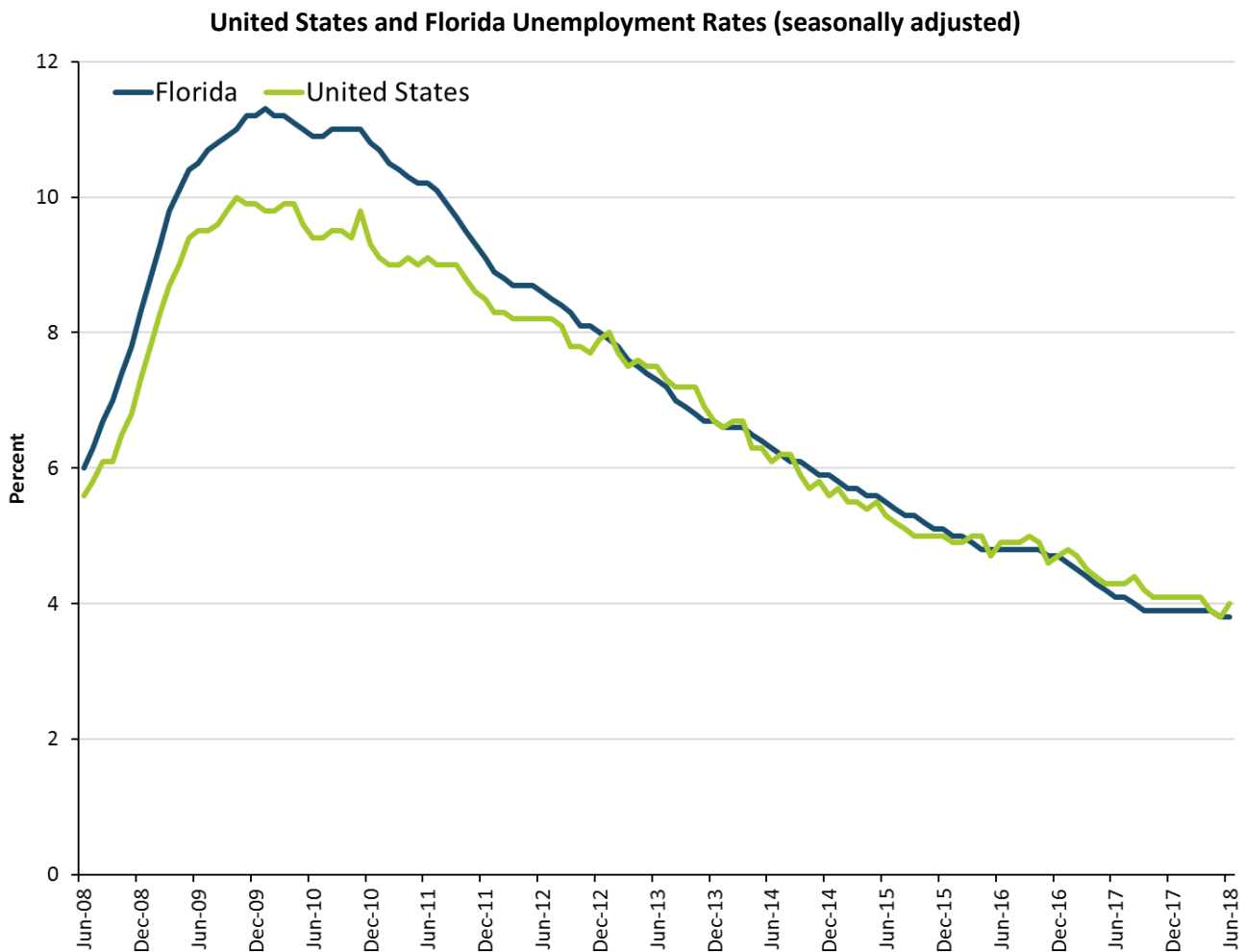


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### Florida's June Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.8 percent in June 2018, staying constant with the May 2018 rate, and down 0.3 percentage point from a year ago. There were 387,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,233,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 4.0 percent in June.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,759,400 in June 2018, an increase of 14,300 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state gained 170,500 jobs over the year, an increase of 2.0 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.6 percent over the year. Prior to September 2017, Florida's over-the-year job growth rate had exceeded the nation's rate since May 2012.
