Paragraph (k) is added to subsection (2) of 12 section 934.03, Florida Statutes, to read: 934.03 Interception and disclosure of wire, oral, or 13 electronic communications prohibited.-14 (2) 15 16 It is lawful under ss. 934.03-934.09 for a child under 17 18 years of age to intercept and record an oral communication if 18 the child is a party to the communication and has reasonable 19 grounds to believe that recording the communication will capture 20 a statement by another party to the communication that the other party intends to commit, is committing, or has committed an 21 unlawful sexual act or an unlawful act of physical force or 22 23 violence against the child. 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
