JUDGMENT AND SENTENCE

You, NINA EVELYN HOLLEY , being personally before this Court represented by ALEXANDER SMITH-JOHNSON, your attorney of record, and having entered a plea of no contest to:

UNL POSS CONTRL SUB

THE COURT, at this time, having given you an opportunity to be heard and show cause why you should not be adjudicated guilty and sentenced as provided by law, including an opportunity to offer matters in mitigation of sentence. No good cause being shown, it is thereupon:

ORDERED that you are hereby adjudicated guilty. It is the sentence of law that you shall be imprisoned in the County Jail of Flagler County, Florida under the supervision of the Board of County Commissioners of said County for a term of 180 days.

ORDERED that you be allowed credit for 16 days.

THE COURT does now advise you that it is your right to appeal from this Judgment and Sentence within thirty days from this date, and you are further advised that you are entitled to the assistance of counsel in taking said appeal, upon a showing that you are entitled to an attorney at the expense of the State.
