## Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

3 Delete everything after the enacting clause 4 and insert:

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Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (7) of section 509.032, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

509.032 Duties.-

- (7) PREEMPTION AUTHORITY.-
- (b) A local law, ordinance, or regulation may regulate activities that arise when a property is used as a vacation



rental provided such regulation applies uniformly to all residential properties without regard to whether the property is used as a vacation rental as defined in s. 509.242 or a longterm rental subject to the provisions of Chapter 83. However, a local law, ordinance, or regulation may not prohibit vacation rentals or regulate the duration or frequency of rentals of vacation rentals. This paragraph does not apply to any local law, ordinance or regulation adopted on or before June 1, 2011, except when such law, ordinance or regulation is being amended to be less restrictive A local law, ordinance, or regulation may not prohibit vacation rentals or regulate the duration or frequency of rental of vacation rentals. This paragraph does not apply to any local law, ordinance, or regulation adopted on or before June 1, 2011.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
