

# **Interstate 95 (I-95) Resurfacing**

**Flagler County**

# **Project Description**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be milling and resurfacing all travel lanes of Interstate 95 (I-95) in Flagler County from the Old Dixie Highway interchange (Exit 278) to the St. Johns County line, including on ramps and off ramps. Work also includes shoulder treatment, quardrail installation, and relocation of two existing median crossovers for emergency vehicles.


The project also will include signal improvements at the State Road (S.R.) 100 and Palm Coast Parkway interchanges, as well as new signing and pavement markings, and Intelligent Transportation Systems (ITS) components for traffic monitoring.

# **What to Expect During Construction**

This project will require lane closures and ramp closures with detours. Most lane closures, as well as the ramp closures, will occur at night. Single daytime lane closures are possible from north of Palm Coast Parkway to the St. Johns County line. Motorists also can expect possible lane closures on S.R. 100 and Palm Coast Parkway to complete the signal improvements.

Electronic message boards and other signage will be used to alert motorists of closures and detours. Updates also can be found on FDOT's Central Florida website www.cflroads.com.
