CAREER HISTORY

Served as a military advisor to Indiana State Police for counter-terrorism at the 1987 Pan Am Games and Los Angeles Police for 1984 summer Olympics. Assisted in the 1983 investigation of the bombing of the Marine Barracks, Beirut, Lebanon. Designated as a subject matter expert in Improvised Explosive Devices and Weapons of Mass Destruction. Conceived and successfully implemented a comprehensive physical security plan for Headquarters, Chief Naval Reserve and Naval Support Activity, New Orleans, LA, resulting in significant reduction of theft of both government and personal property. Initiated planning and coordination of Marine Corps Reserve force employment with the U.S. Border Patrol in drug interdiction operations along the Southwest (US) border. Served as a member of the United States Marine Corps task team for the development of the Special Operations Capability (SOC) within Marine Corps Expeditionary Units. This work team focused on the introduction of special weapons and training utilizing unique tactics within these Expeditionary Units to significantly enhance firepower and covert skills. Developed and implemented plans to assist the United States Border Patrol for drug interdiction along the Southwest border of Texas.

Taught both Technical and Vocational criminal justice courses to include Basic Law Enforcement (BLE) "high risk" classes at the Northeast Florida Criminal Justice Training and Education Center.
