Judge Nichols,

Good morning, my name is Joshua Seth King, on 11Jan2024, I was pulled over while driving under the influence. I was sentenced to 1 yr in jail or a rehab, I had chosen to go to Faith Farms in Okeechobee, FL. I am requesting a Status Hearing to my orders to be modified to a half-way house or to Victory House. Unfortunately, I was sent back to Mississippi for probation violation in arrived at MDOC in June 2024, I have was paroled on March 6, 2026, where I was sent to Faith farms to begin my sober journey. My intake was with Brian at Faith Farms, where they were made aware of my non-religious beliefs in God with my stepdad and mom standing right there. I was told that this was not an issue.

I have been now going on 60 days. I have spoken to my Probation Officer in regards to issues that I am currently having at the location. When we first started the paperwork they were told that I am not overly Christian, but will participate to my comfort levels when conducting myself in the rehab therapy. This location has been mentally abusive by trying to have me sever my family due to the beliefs do not follow their beliefs. My mother came down for Easter service to see me since I arrived. She was informed via the phone that she couldn't bring her service animal with her and that she must attend their church to be able to see her son. Which she has done at my request. My mother's reaction was needless to say Shocked. Her impression was of a Cult, do as I say not as I do. There tactics insulted her religious beliefs as well as the way that they forced her to be there without her service animal, and listen to their teachings. She came in with a open mind to the religious program, but left utterly shocked, insulted, and extremely worried about the rights being violated. My 1st Amendment has been stomped on by this administration, due to them using his against me as being of a different faith and refusing to lie in any church.

Last week, I was forced to pray with them and told I had no choice in the matter. So I completed the prayer as directed by the teachers at the farm. Afterwards, I expressed that I was upset about it and was confronted with you will do this otherwise. When I first arrived I was working on the farm feeding the animals, then on week 3 I was moved to the truck for picking up donations. I have since been moved to the kitchen, after being told I am not Christian enough to be outside.

I brought to the attention of Nikki, about the force prayer. He stated that I will have to confess God (Christianity) in Phase 3, if not I will be kicked out of the program. I stated but I don't follow, please explain, Nikki informed me that I have 3 choices, Confess to God, Fake it really well, or get kicked out.

I feel that I am being told if I don't lie about confessing God, that I have no place here at Faith Farms. I feel now that I have been told this, they are set on kicking me out of the placement. I would like to request that my probation be moved to a half-way house, or to a rehab closer to my family. I do not want to violate my probation here, and would like to be moved to a location that is more suitable to my mental and physical health. To lie in a church of God for the reason of staying in the program is being a hypocrite, and how many others who are in this same situation are here now confessing to God and lying about it.

While in Mississippi prison, I had a lot of time to reflect and see where I needed to correct and guide myself as well as others in the right direction. While there I completed several classes, and began teaching as well to other prisoner's in a multitude of classes from anger management to diversity. While I was at Flagler awaiting my extradition to Mississippi, I completed the Alcohol and drug training course ran by Victory House through the jail itself where I met, three outstanding individuals who helped me question many things in regards to the Bible and healing. I am not a Christian but a Wicca, but I do not believe that forcing me to lie to any God is against my Constitutional Rights as a human being.

I am respectfully requesting to move to any State approved half-way house, or be considered time served due to my time in Mississippi prison for over 2yrs since my arrest (1/11/24 to 3/6/26) to begin the journey of the rest of my life with reconnecting with my 5 yr old son, and my family. I have been sober since getting pulled over in Jan 2024. I have made the choice to move forward to being an asset to my community and family.

Thank you for the courts and your time Honor.

ORDER OF PROBATION

This cause coming before the Court to be heard, and you, the defendant, being now present before the court, and you having

- entered a plea of guilty to been found guilty by jury verdict of
- entered a plea of nolo contendere to been found guilty by the court trying the case without a jury of

SECTION 1: JUDGMENT OF GUILT

The court hereby adjudges you to be guilty of the above offense(s).

Now, therefore, it is ordered and adjudged that the imposition of sentence is hereby withheld and that you be placed on Probation for a period of Sixty (60) Months under the supervision of the Department of Corrections, subject to Florida law.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you shall comply with the following standard conditions of supervision as provided by Florida law:

- (1) You will report to the probation officer as directed.
- (2) You will pay the State of Florida the amount of \$50.00 per month, as well as 4% surcharge, toward the cost of your supervision in accordance with s. 948.09, F.S., unless otherwise exempted in compliance with Florida Statutes.
- (3) You will remain in a specified place. You will not change your residence or employment or leave the county of your residence without first procuring the consent of your officer.
- (4) You will not possess, carry or own any firearm. You will not possess, carry, or own any weapon without first procuring the consent of your officer.
- (5) You will live without violating any law. A conviction in a court of law is not necessary for such a violation of law to constitute a violation of your probation, community control, or any other form of court ordered supervision.
- (6) You will not associate with any person engaged in any criminal activity.
- (7) You will not use intoxicants to excess or possess any drugs or narcotics unless prescribed by a physician, an advanced practice registered nurse, or a physician assistant. Nor will you visit places where intoxicants, drugs or other dangerous substances are unlawfully sold, dispensed or used.
- (8) You will work diligently at a lawful occupation, advise your employer of your probation status, and support any dependents to the best of your ability, as directed by your officer.
- (9) You will promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed to you by the court or the officer, and allow your officer to visit in your home, at your employment site or elsewhere, and you will comply with all instructions your officer may give you.

- (10) You will pay restitution, court costs, and/or fees in accordance with special conditions imposed or in accordance with the attached orders.
- (11) You will submit to random testing as directed by your officer or the professional staff of the treatment center where you are receiving treatment to determine the presence or use of alcohol or controlled substances.
- (12) You will submit a DNA sample, as directed by your officer, for DNA analysis as prescribed in ss. 943.325 and 948.014, F.S.
- (13) You will submit to the taking of a digitized photograph by the department. This photograph may be displayed on the department's website while you are on supervision, unless exempt from disclosure due to requirements of s. 119.07, F.S.
- (14) You will report in person within 72 hours of your release from incarceration to the probation office in Flagler County, Florida, unless otherwise instructed by the court or department. (This condition applies only if section 3 on the previous page is checked.) Otherwise, you must report immediately to the probation office located at 2405 East Moody Blvd., Suite 301, Bunnell, FL 32110.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

4. You will enter the Department of Corrections Non-Secure Drug Treatment Program or other residential treatment program/Probation and Restitution Center for a period of successful completion as approved by your officer. You are to remain until you successfully complete said Program and Aftercare. You are to comply with all Rules and Regulations of the Program. You shall be confined in the county jail until placement in said program, and if you are confined in the jail, the Sheriff will transport you to said program.

Additional Instructions: FAITH FARMS

8. You will successfully complete 50 hours of community service at a work site approved by your officer.
23. Pay \$1 per month during the term of probation or community control to supplement rehabilitative efforts through First Step Funds, pursuant to s. 948.039(2), F.S.
27. Alcohol Safety Education Course (ASEC).
28. Victim Impact Panel (VIP).
29. 2 Year Ignition Interlock Device.
30. 90 Day Vehicle Impound.
31. 10 Year Driver's License Suspension.
32. Possible Early Termination after 24 Months.

Effective for offenders whose crime was committed on or after September 1, 2005, there is hereby imposed, in addition to any other provision in this section, mandatory electronic monitoring as a condition of supervision for those who:

- Are placed on supervision for a violation of chapter 794, s. 800.04(4), (5), or (6), s. 827.071, or s. 847.0145 and the unlawful sexual activity involved a victim 15 years of age or younger and the offender is 18 years of age or older; or
- Are designated as a sexual predator pursuant to s. 775.21; or
- Has previously been convicted of a violation of chapter 794, s. 800.04(4), (5), or (6), s. 827.071, or s. 847.0145 and the unlawful sexual activity involved a victim 15 years of age or younger and the offender is 18 years of age or older.

You are hereby placed on notice that should you violate your probation or community control, and the conditions set forth in s. 948.063(1) or (2) are satisfied, whether your probation or community control is revoked or not revoked, you shall be placed on electronic monitoring in accordance with F.S. 948.063.

Effective for offenders who are subject to supervision for a crime that was committed on or after May 26, 2010, and who has been convicted at any time of committing, or attempting, soliciting, or conspiring to commit, any of the criminal offenses listed in s. 943.0435(1)(h)1.a.(I), or a similar offense in another jurisdiction, against a victim who was under the age of 18 at the time of the offense; the following conditions are imposed in addition to all other conditions:

(a) A prohibition on visiting schools, child care facilities, parks, and playgrounds, without prior approval from the offender's supervising officer. The court may also designate additional locations to protect a victim. The prohibition ordered under this paragraph does not prohibit the offender from visiting a school, child care facility, park, or playground for the sole purpose of attending a religious service as defined in s. 775.0861 or picking up or dropping off the offender's children or grandchildren at a child care facility or school.

(b) A prohibition on distributing candy or other items to children on Halloween; wearing a Santa Claus costume, or other costume to appeal to children, on or preceding Christmas; wearing an Easter Bunny costume, or other costume to appeal to children, on or preceding Easter; entertaining at children's parties; or wearing a clown costume; without prior approval from the court.

Effective for offenders whose crime was committed on or after October 1, 2014, and who is placed on probation or community control for a violation of chapter 794, s. 800.04, s. 827.071, s. 847.0135(5), or s. 847.0145, in addition to all other conditions imposed, is prohibited from viewing, accessing, owning, or possessing any obscene, pornographic, or sexually stimulating visual or auditory material unless otherwise indicated in the treatment plan provided by a qualified practitioner in the sexual offender treatment program. Visual or auditory material includes, but is not limited to, telephone, electronic media, computer programs, and computer services.

YOU ARE HEREBY PLACED ON NOTICE that the court may at any time rescind or modify any of the conditions of your probation, or may extend the period of probation as authorized by law, or may discharge you from further supervision. If you violate any of the conditions of your probation, you may be arrested and the court may revoke your probation, adjudicate you guilty if adjudication of guilt was withheld, and impose any sentence that it might have imposed before placing you on probation or require you to serve the balance of the sentence.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that when you have been instructed as to the conditions of probation, you shall be released from custody if you are in custody, and if you are at liberty on bond, the sureties thereon shall stand discharged from liability. (This paragraph applies only if section 1 or section 2 is checked.)

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that you pay:
Court Costs, Fees, and Fines, as imposed at sentencing, in the total amount of: \$ 3,136.00

Payments processed through the Department of Corrections will be assessed a 4% surcharge pursuant to s. 945.31, F.S.
Pursuant to s. 948.09, F.S., you will be assessed an amount of \$2.00 per month for each month of supervision for the Training Trust Fund Surcharge.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the clerk of this court file this order in the clerk's office and provide certified copies of same to the officer for use in compliance with the requirements of law.
