RESOLUTION 2025-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF MARINELAND OF FLAGLER COUNTY AND ST. JOHNS COUNTY, FLORIDA, ADOPTING THE FINAL LEVYING OF AD VALOREM TAXES FOR MARINELAND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Whereas, the Town of Marineland of Flagler County and St. Johns County, Monday, on September 29, 2025 adopted fiscal year 2025-2026 final millage rates following a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

Whereas, the Town of Marineland of Flagler County and St. Johns County, Florida, held a public hearing as required by Florida Statute 200.065; and

Whereas, the gross taxable value for operating purposes not exempt from taxation within Flagler County has been certified by the County Property Appraiser to the Town of Marineland as \$13,021,841.

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Town of Marineland of Flagler County and St. Johns County, Florida, that:

- 1. The fiscal year 2025-2026 operating millage rate is 10.0000 mills which is less than the rolled-back rate of 10.1293 mills.
- 2. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
