(1) HOW VIOLATION OCCURRED:

Violation of Condition (9) of the Order of Drug Offender Probation, by failing to promptly and truthfully answer all inquiries directed by the probation officer, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer Casey Sherrill states that on January 13th, 2020, the offender did answer untruthfully an inquiry by the probation officer as to having contact with Law Enforcement.

Violation of Special Condition (15b) of the Order of Drug Offender Probation, by failing to abstain entirely from the use of alcohol and/or illegal drugs, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer Casey Sherrill states that the offender did use illegal drugs, to wit: **INHALANTS**, on January 13th, 2020 as evidenced by Flagler County Sheriff's Office Agency Case Report# 2020-00004007, dated January 13th, 2020, and the offender's own admission on January 16th, 2020.

Circumstances: On 01/13/2020 at approximately 8:34am the Flagler County Sheriff's Office received a call from a passer-by who witnessed that the offender (Mason Brown) was passed out behind the wheel of his vehicle on the side of the road. Upon Deputies making contact with the offender, he became conscious and refused medical care. He stated that he had just bought the air dusters from Wal-Mart. The offender's neighbor arrived on scene to pick him up and transport his vehicle home. On 01/13/2020 at approximately 10:55am, the offender reported to the probation office and filled out a supervision monthly report. One of the details on the supervision monthly report is "Contact with Law Enforcement- If you had any contact with law enforcement this past month, explain details here:" which the offender wrote "None". On 01/15/2020 this officer received correspondence from Sergeant Daniel Weaver at Flagler County Sheriff's Office that alleged the offender was involved in the above-mentioned incident where he was "huffing" air duster and became unconscious. This officer did not receive this correspondence until 01/16/2020, at which time this officer immediately called the offender into the probation office to discuss this matter. The offender admitted to this officer that he did answer untruthfully on his supervision monthly report, and he was "shaking" out in the probation office

lobby while waiting for this officer on Monday, thinking this officer had already knew what happened. The offender admitted that he purchased the air duster cans form Wal-Mart, but states he did not buy them for the intended purposes of huffing them, although that is what he ended up doing. He further said that he remembered huffing air duster when he was 16 or 17 years old and he wanted to try it again. He stated that as he was driving down the road and going over the railroad tracks when he huffed the air duster, at which time the passer-by saw him do so and began to follow him while they called 911. The offender denies losing consciousness at any time. The offender denies that he has a problem with huffing inhalants and says this was a "one-time" thing.

(2) **OFFENDER'S STATEMENT:** The offender is adamant this is a "one time" thing and he does not have a problem with inhalants.

(3) **HISTORY OF SUPERVISION:** ADJUDICATION WITHHELD ADJUDICATED

Original sentence: On 08/16/2019 the offender was sentenced to thirty-six (36) months Drug Offender Probation.


