**MOTION TO MODIFY NO CONTACT ORDER TO NO VIOLENT CONTACT AND TO  
REMOVE DEFENDANT'S GPS MONITORING**

Defendant, JOEL BUZZARD, by and through her undersigned counsel hereby requests this Honorable Court to modify the existing no contact order to reflect that Defendant is allowed to have no violent contact with alleged victim and to remove the Defendant's GPS monitoring. As grounds for this Motion, Defendant states as follows:

1. The alleged victim wishes to have the no contact order modified to reflect that the Defendant is allowed to have no violent contact with the alleged victim.
2. Since the alleged victim wishes to have the no contact order modified to no violent contact, there is no longer a need for the Defendant to be on GPS monitoring.
3. Assistant State Attorney, TARA LIBBY, objects to this Motion.
4. All other conditions of Pretrial Release remain in place.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that this Honorable Court permit Defendant to have no violent contact with the alleged victim and to remove the Defendant's GPS monitoring.
