TO WIT

On November 15, 2014 at approximately 2305 hours I was contacted by the Flagler County Communications Center in reference to a shooting that occurred at 6351 Cherry Lane in Bunnell, FL. Upon arrival I made contact with Corporal Weaver who briefed me on the incident.

It was learned that Flagler County Sheriff's Office personnel had responded to this address in reference to a 911 call that came in regarding an attempted suicide. A female, later identified as Tiffany Norman, the victim, called 911 and requested an ambulance. That 911 call can be summarized as follows:

When the 911 dispatcher answered the 911 call Ms. Norman stated, "I need an ambulance right now", Ms. Norman stated several times that she needed an ambulance but she was unable to explain why she needed it. A male, later identified as Jonathan Canales, the defendant, then began speaking and stated, "She shot herself in the head. She was trying to commit suicide and I wouldn't let her. I just came home from work and she was bleeding all over the place. She was bleeding all over the place and all over the kitchen and I just came home at 8:30." The dispatcher then asked Mr. Canales where the gun was and you can clearly hear Ms. Norman in the background state, "Stop lying". Mr. Canales then states, "The gun is over on Maple." The dispatcher then again asks where the gun was, and Canales states, "The gun is over the bed." Dispatch then asks where Ms. Norman is and Mr. Canales stated that she was in the bathroom. Canales further stated, "I'm a disabled war veteran I didn't do anything besides coming home from work, and when I came home from work, unlocked the door, I heard a loud pop and I fuckin', I found my 22 come in, like she had it right up against her head. The dispatcher then asks if Mr. Canales saw Ms. Norman shoot herself and he stated, "Do what, no Ma'am. I came in from work and she had my 22 up against her head." There is more information gathered by the dispatcher and Mr. Canales stays on the telephone with her until Sheriff's Office personnel arrive on scene. A full recording of the 911 call has been attached to this case in AEGIS.(records management system)

As I arrived on scene it was learned that Ms. Norman had been transported to Halifax Medical Center via helicopter. After being briefed by Corporal Weaver I proceeded inside the residence and made contact with Jonathan Canales. Mr. Canales was seated in the kitchen and dressed in nothing but a pair of green boxer shorts. I asked Mr. Canales what happened, and to para phrase, he stated that he had been outside working in his shed, Tiffany has been "bitching" a lot lately about her home life, he walked in the house, and saw Tiffany with a Remington 22 to her head. Mr. Canales then stated that as he was approaching Tiffany, she shot herself in the neck. After listening to Mr. Canales' account of the incident there were several inconsistencies noted.

Upon the initial walkthrough of the residence there were multiple firearms observed in plain view. There were two handguns observed right outside of the threshold of a bedroom in which the three children were sleeping. It was later discovered that these weapons were loaded and operable. There was a large area of pooled blood in the hallway area and several spots of blood throughout the residence.

Mr. Canales voluntarily agreed to be interviewed at the Investigative Services Division. Upon arrival Mr. Canales was advised of his Constitutional rights and signed a form waiving those rights and agreed to speak with me. The video recorded interview with Canales can be summarized as follows:

Mr. Canales stated that he and Ms. Norman had been arguing most of the day because she was upset about her life. Mr. Canales stated that he had been working out in the garage from approximately noon to 19:30 hours. When he came back in the residence he went directly to a room in the rear of the residence where he played billiards for "a little while". When Mr. Canales exited that room and proceeded towards the front of the residence he observed Ms. Norman in a seated position at the end of a mattress on the floor of the living room with the Remington 22 pointed at her head. Mr. Canales stated that he approached Ms. Norman, grabbed the gun, and attempted to move it away from her, "and it popped". Mr. Canales stated that Ms. Norman had the weapon pointed "right to her face" but when he attempted to get it away from her it moved to her neck. Mr. Canales stated that when he heard the weapon discharge, Ms. Norman appeared to be "perfectly normal". He stated that originally he thought the bullet missed her, but then realized that the bullet had hit her because there was blood everywhere. Mr. Canales stated that he and Ms. Norman began cleaning up the blood and that she appeared to "be okay with it". After about 10 or 15 minutes, Mr. Canales decided that it would be best to call 911 and get her treatment. For those 10 or 15 minutes Mr. Canales had been applying pressure to the wound in an attempt to stop the bleeding. Mr. Canales stated that he then assisted Ms. Norman to the bathroom where she continued to bleed and he decided to call 911 at that time.

On 11-17-14 I attempted to speak with Ms. Norman at Halifax Hospital, however, her condition was too poor for her to adequately communicate.

On 11-25-14 I proceeded to Halifax Hospital in Daytona Beach where I interviewed Ms. Norman. For the first time she was able to recall most of the events that occurred on the night of the incident. I asked Ms. Norman to explain the sequence of events that happened to her on 11-15-14 and she was able to do so.

On 11-15-14 Ms. Norman explained to Mr. Canales that they needed to respond to South Daytona to retrieve a pair of prescription glasses for her son. Mr. Canales balked at the idea of traveling all the way to South Daytona for a pair of glasses and refused to allow Ms. Norman to go. Mr. Canales decided that the day would be better spent visiting garage sales in the area and left the residence leaving Ms. Norman and the 3 children at home.

Upon Mr. Canales' return, Ms. Norman expressed her desire to take the kids to the park for the afternoon and Mr. Canales refused to allow her to take the car so Ms. Norman walked with her children to the park. With darkness approaching, Ms. Canales left the park and walked home with her children. Upon her arrival at home she discovered that Mr. Canales had locked all of the doors and refused to let her inside. Ms. Norman sat on the rear porch for approximately an hour before Mr. Canales allowed them to enter the residence.

Upon entering the residence Ms. Norman prepared dinner for her children. Ms. Norman stated that she recalls looking at a clock in the kitchen and it was 7:00 pm when the kids were eating. Ms. Norman then dressed the children in their pajamas and she put them to bed. Ms. Norman then proceeded to the kitchen and began eating her dinner. Ms. Norman stated that she was seated with her back to the living room and Mr. Canales walked passed her into the kitchen with, what she identified as "the 22", strapped to his chest. Mr. Canales made a drink and stood at the refrigerator and stated to Ms. Norman, "You don't know how many easy ways there are to kill you and nobody would know about it." Mr. Canales then walks back into the living room and approaches Ms. Norman from behind

and again states, "I could kill you and nobody would even know about it, not even your family". Ms. Norman stated that she then heard something "pop" and she assumed that Mr. Canales walk away. She then felt a very sharp pain in her neck and had "buzzing" in her ear. Ms. Norman remembers seeing herself fall to the kitchen floor and then passing out.

Ms. Norman stated that she woke up and was trying to get up but she could not make her body cooperate with her mind. Mr. Canales was trying to pick her up while he was stating, "I didn't want to but it had to be done. It needed to be done." Ms. Norman stated that as Mr. Canales was taking her to the bathroom it felt as if she were being flung around. Mr. Canales took her to the bathroom and threw her on the side of the tub. Mr. Canales then completely disrobed her and put her entirely into the tub. He again stated, "I don't want to but it needed to be done. It had to be done but you're not going to ruin my life over this." At that point Ms. Norman stated that she was "begging" for an ambulance or for Mr. Canales to call her mom. Ms. Norman stated that she just kept begging for Mr. Canales to call her mom and he stated that he would but he had to "clean all this up first". Then he reentered the bathroom and stated, "You're not ruining my life over this stupid nonsense. I'm not going to jail for you for this. It's not my fault it's your fault." At that time Mr. Canales turned off the bathroom light and exited the bathroom closing the door behind him leaving Ms. Norman in the tub.

Ms. Norman stated after some time she was able to muster enough of her own strength to exit the tub, put on clothes that she found on the bathroom floor, and proceeded to the table looking for her phone. The phone was not where she left it on the table so she asked Mr. Canales for the phone. Ms. Norman stated that she explained to Mr. Canales that she was bleeding and needed to go to the hospital. Mr. Canales refused to provide Ms. Norman with her telephone. She located Mr. Canales telephone and used it to call 911 for assistance. Ms. Norman was speaking to the 911 dispatcher trying to explain what had occurred and Mr. Canales took the phone from her and began speaking. Ms. Norman stated that Mr. Canales just kept saying that he was not going to go to jail over this and that it was all her fault.

Ms. Norman stated that at no time did Mr. Canales attempt to render aid in any fashion, contrary to his statements. Ms. Norman stated that she did not, in any way shoot herself, contrary to his statements. On the 911 call Mr. Canales stated that there was blood "all over the kitchen" which was not located upon law enforcement arrival. Mr. Norman estimates that she was shot at approximately 8:00 pm and the call did not come into 911 until 10:45 pm. Mr. Canales told investigators that he helped dress, care for, and compress the wound with multiple articles of clothing, and that he carried Ms. Norman to the tub, and that he had not washed himself or bathed, yet there was no blood located anywhere on him. Mr. Canales gave conflicting statements as to the way he claims to have located Ms. Norman and the shot occurred. All physical evidence on the scene contradicts the account of the incident as described by Mr. Canales and it supports the account of the incident as described by Ms. Norman. After having taken all of the aforementioned into consideration there is probable cause to believe that Mr. Canales did commit the offenses listed herein.


