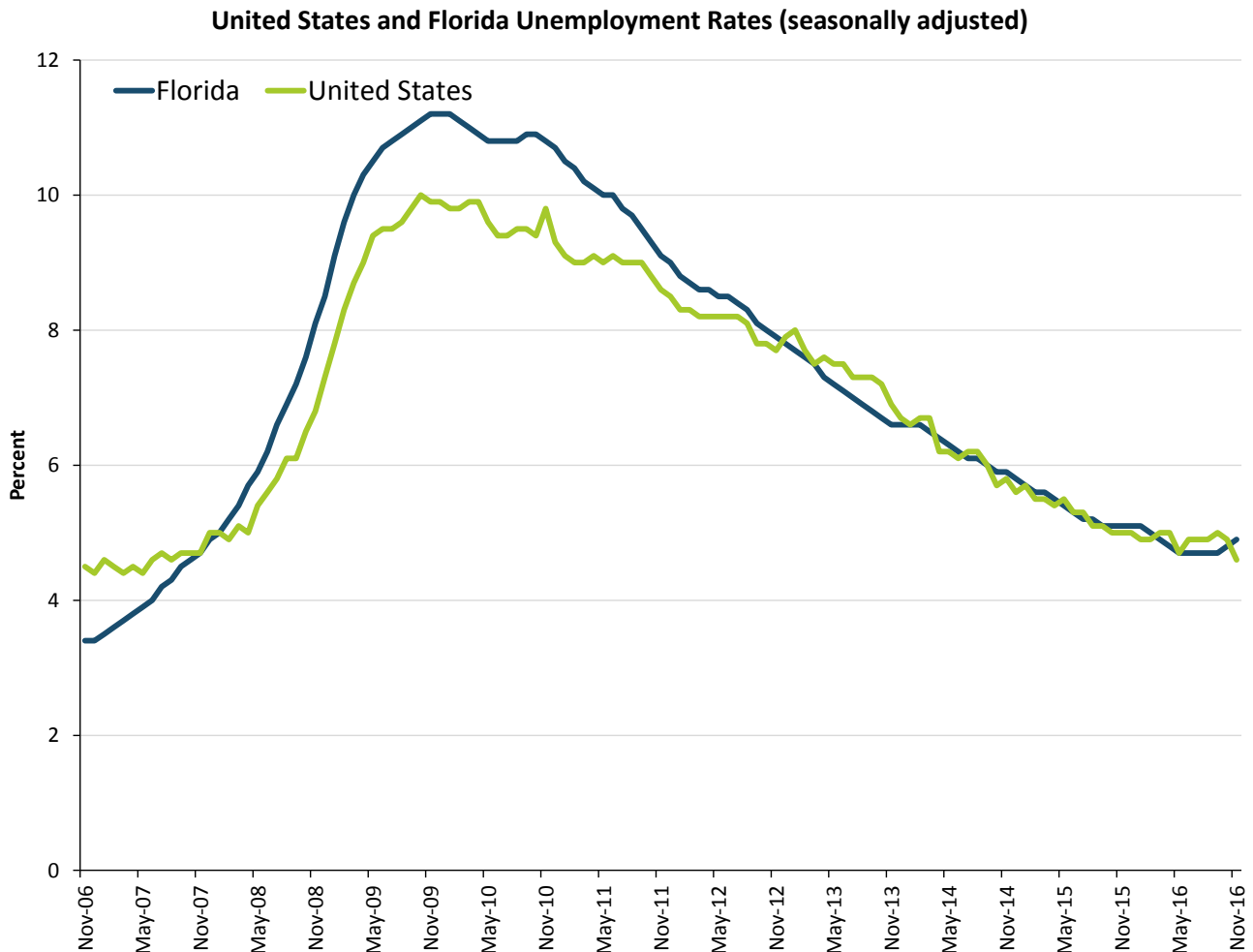

Florida's November Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.9 percent in November 2016, up 0.1 percentage point from the October 2016 rate, but down 0.2 percentage point from 5.1 percent a year ago. There were 482,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 9,881,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 4.6 percent in November.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,465,000 in November 2016, an increase of 29,600 jobs (+0.4 percent) over the month. The state gained 263,900 jobs over the year, an increase of 3.2 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.6 percent over the year. Florida's over-the-year job growth rate has exceeded the nation's rate since May 2012.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,465,000 in November 2016, up 263,900 jobs compared to a year ago. November 2016 was the 76th consecutive month with positive over-the-year job growth. The industry gaining the most jobs was leisure and hospitality (+57,300 jobs, +5.0 percent).
- Other industries gaining jobs included professional and business services (+51,500 jobs, +4.1 percent); education and health services (+50,000 jobs, +4.1 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+36,100 jobs, +2.1 percent); construction (+23,200 jobs, +5.3 percent); financial activities (+16,100 jobs, +3.0 percent); government (+12,500 jobs, +1.2 percent); manufacturing (+10,700 jobs, +3.1 percent); and other services (+7,200 jobs, +2.1 percent).
- The only industry that lost jobs over the year was information (-700 jobs, -0.5 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In November 2016, Monroe County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (3.2 percent), followed by St. Johns County (3.8 percent), and Lafayette County (4.1 percent).
- Hendry County had the highest unemployment rate (9.1 percent) in Florida in November 2016, followed by Sumter County (7.0 percent), and Citrus and Highlands counties (6.8 percent each).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- All twenty-four metro areas in the state had over-the-year job gains in November 2016. The areas with the largest gains were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (+53,100 jobs, +4.5 percent), Tampa-St. Petersburg-Clearwater (+33,400 jobs, +2.6 percent), and Ft. Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach (+30,700 jobs, +3.8 percent).

Note: The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
