- Periods of Gusty Showers and Locally Heavy Rain along the I-95 Corridor on Sunday



Coastal Hazards this Weekend & Monday

- Frequent Deadly Rip Currents, Rough Surf & Beach Erosion
- Tropical Storm Conditions Expected Offshore Sunday and Sunday Night



Widely Scattered Thunderstorms Today and Saturday

- Strongest Storms Afternoon & Early Evening for Locations North of Waycross
- Main Hazards: Gusty winds & Locally Heavy Rain

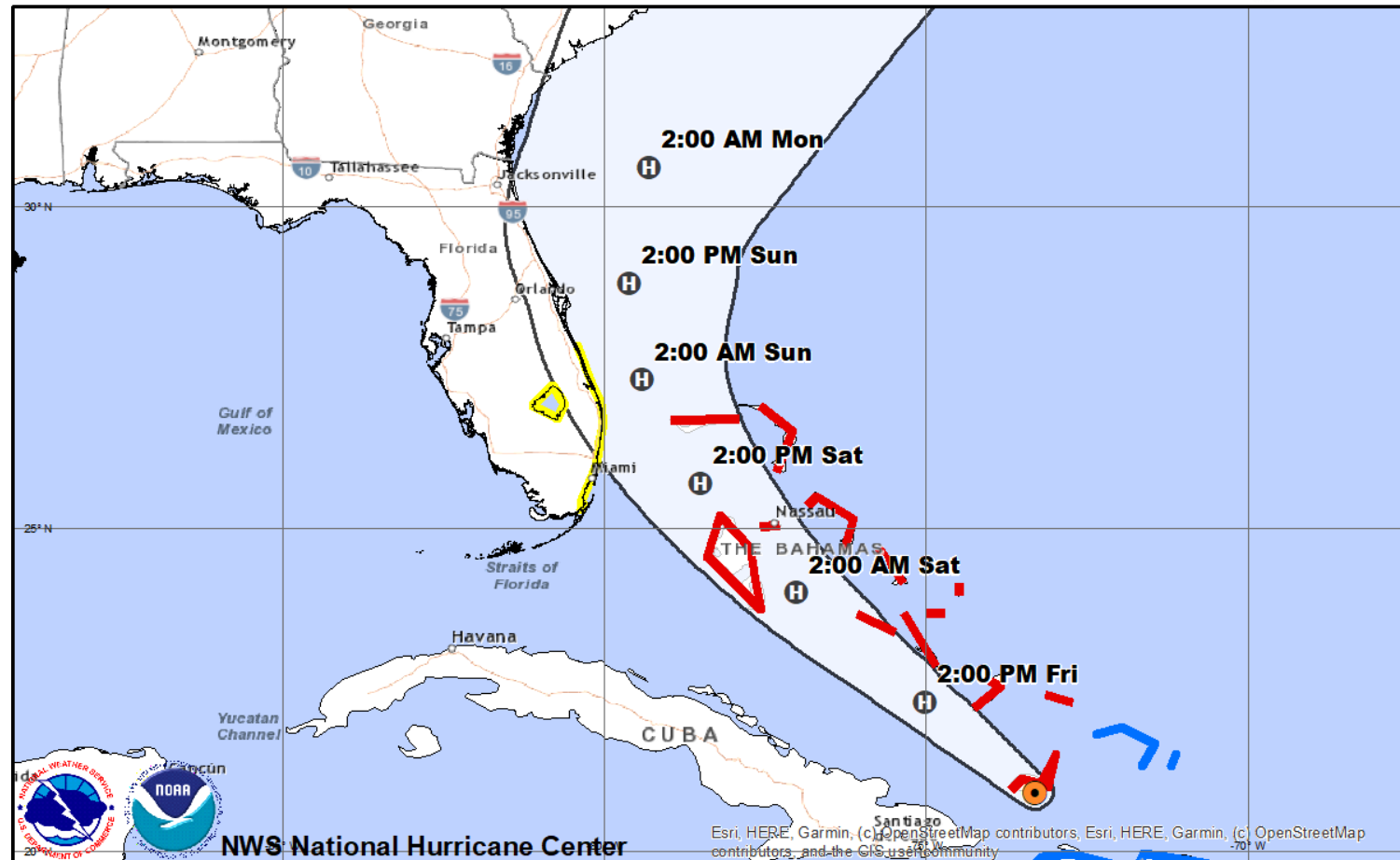
Local Impacts
