

Weather Impact Overview

Southeast Georgia & Northeast Florida



Periods of Heavy Rainfall through Wednesday

- Heaviest potential through this evening today
- Overall, needed rainfall – low widespread flood threat today
- Training storms along the front could produce localized flooding rainfall



Strong to Isolated Severe Storms Today & Wednesday

- NE FL this morning, then SE GA & NE FL this afternoon
- Hazards: Damaging Wind Gusts & Hail
- Low potential for isolated tornadoes



Preparedness Actions


 Know where you will shelter if storms threaten

Today through Thursday


Storm Total Rainfall Forecast
