## Monitor Tropical Storm Isaias

- Local Impacts *Possible* Late this Weekend or Early Next Week
- Building Surf & Elevated Rip Current Risk Expected Fri-Mon
- Too Early to Speculate on Specific Rainfall or Wind Impacts



## Daily Thunderstorm Potential

- Late Morning I-75 corridor, moving east to Atlantic Coast in afternoon
- Strongest Storms Afternoon & Evening
- Main Hazards: Gusty winds, Locally Heavy Rain & Frequent Lightning

# Tropical Storm Isaias

Storm forecast to curve northwest then north the next few days

Late this Weekend or Early Next Week

## Potential Local Impacts

- **Marine & Coastal Impacts:**  
Building Surf, Beach Erosion, Elevated Rip Current Risk Fri-Mon
- Rainfall Outlook: Too Early to Speculate
- Wind Outlook: Too Early to Speculate
