Southeast Georgia & Northeast Florida



Tropical Storm Mindy moves through Area Tonight into Thursday

- **Wind Advisory** – I-10 corridor – Gusts up to 40 MPH possible
- Waves of rain & t'storms – gusty winds, heavy rainfall & isolated tornado potential
- Localized Flood Potential late tonight Suwannee Valley then Area-Wide Thursday
- Storm total rainfall 1-3 inches



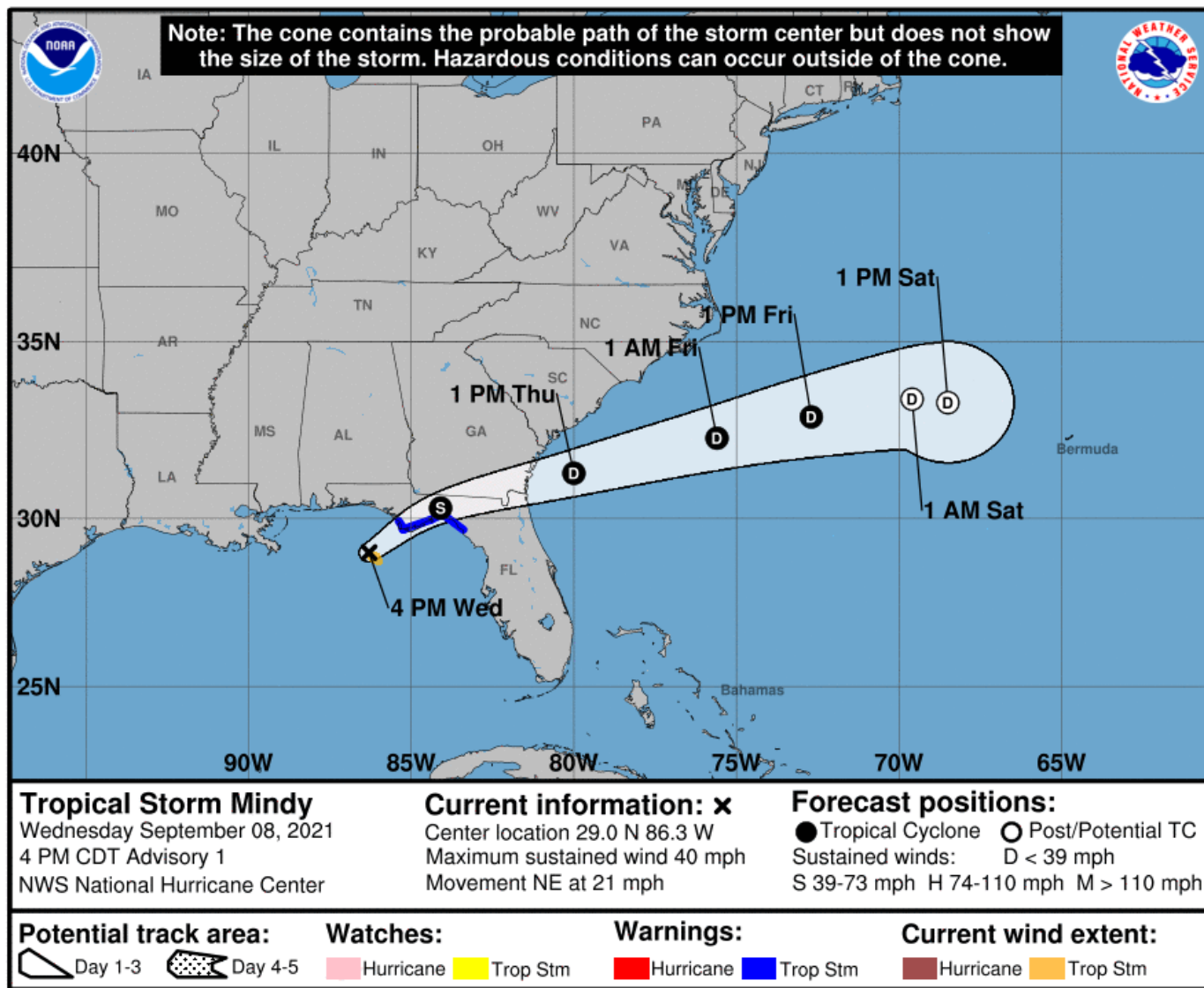
Coastal & Marine Hazards

- **Gale Warning** – Thursday – 40 mph gusts and 4-7 ft waves
- Frequent Rip Currents - High Rip Current Risk

Tropical Storm Mindy



- TS Mindy will move over SE GA / NE FL tonight and early Thursday.
- Greatest Impacts: Suwannee Valley, I-75 corridor
- Impacts:
 - Heavy Rainfall
 - Localized Flooding
 - Gusty winds
 - Isolated Tornadoes

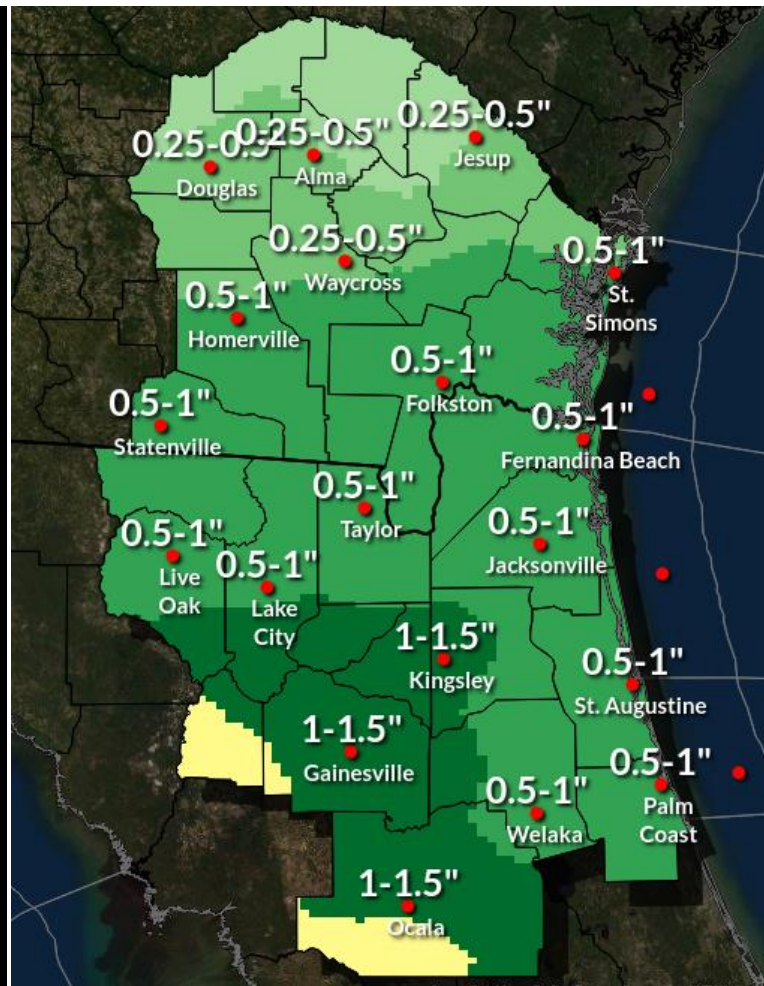
Locally Heavy Rain Possible Through Thursday



Mainly near the Suwannee Valley and I-75 Corridor

Marginal Risk for Excessive Rain into Tonight

Storm Total Rainfall through Thursday



- Training storms could lead to localized heavy rainfall, especially over Suwannee Valley.
- About 2 to 3 inches of rainfall in Suwannee Valley/I-75 corridor
- 1 inch of rainfall elsewhere
