Isolated To Scattered Strong to Severe T'Storms Today

- Ending across Se GA this morning
- Redeveloping along and East of U.S. Highway 301 this afternoon into early evening
- **Hazards:** Wind Gusts of 40-60 mph, Frequent Lightning Strikes, Small Hail & Heavy Downpours

Minor Flooding Continues Along Portions of the Satilla River



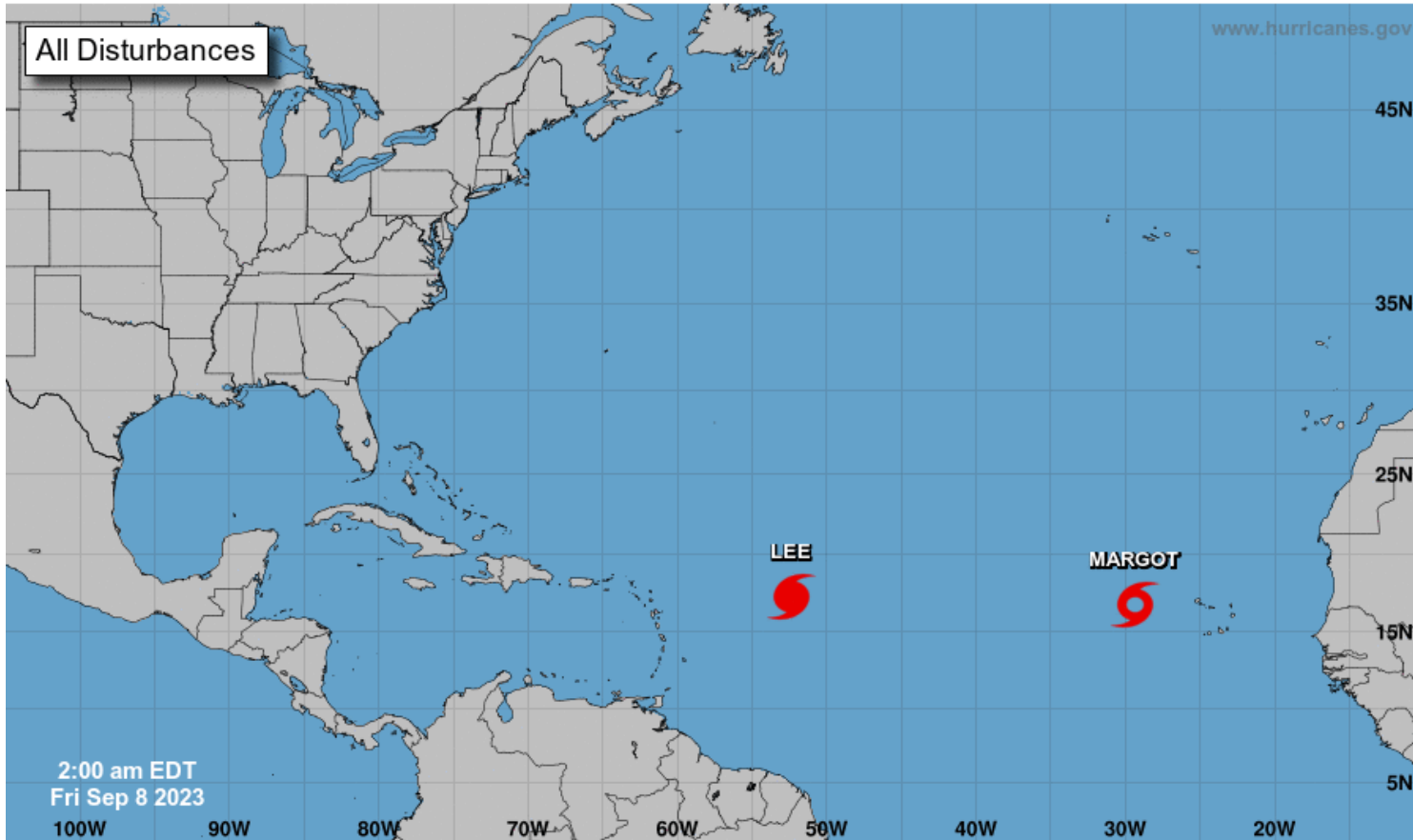
