

# Weather Impact Key Messages

Northeast Florida & Southeast Georgia

- Strong to Severe Storms on Wednesday
  - Tornado Watch in Effect for parts of SE GA and NE FL Through 1 PM EDT
  - Squall Line of Strong to Severe Storms Crosses Our Region from NW to SE
  - Timing: Through Early to Mid Afternoon
  - Hazards: Damaging Wind Gusts of 50-70 mph, Hail & Isolated Tornadoes
- Wind Advisory for Most of NE FL
  - Non Thunderstorm Winds 15-25 mph, Gusts to 40 mph
- Small Craft Advisory Wednesday & Wednesday Night
- Moderate Rip Current Risk at All Area Beaches through Wednesday
- Minor River Flooding Portions of the Altamaha, Satilla and Santa Fe Rivers




