## **Strong to Severe Storms on Wednesday**

- Tornado Watch in Effect for parts of SE GA and NE FL Through 1 PM EDT
- Squall Line of Strong to Severe Storms Crosses Our Region from NW to SE
- Timing: Through Early to Mid Afternoon
- Hazards: Damaging Wind Gusts of 50-70 mph, Hail & Isolated Tornadoes



## **Wind Advisory for Most of NE FL**

- Non Thunderstorm Winds 15-25 mph, Gusts to 40 mph

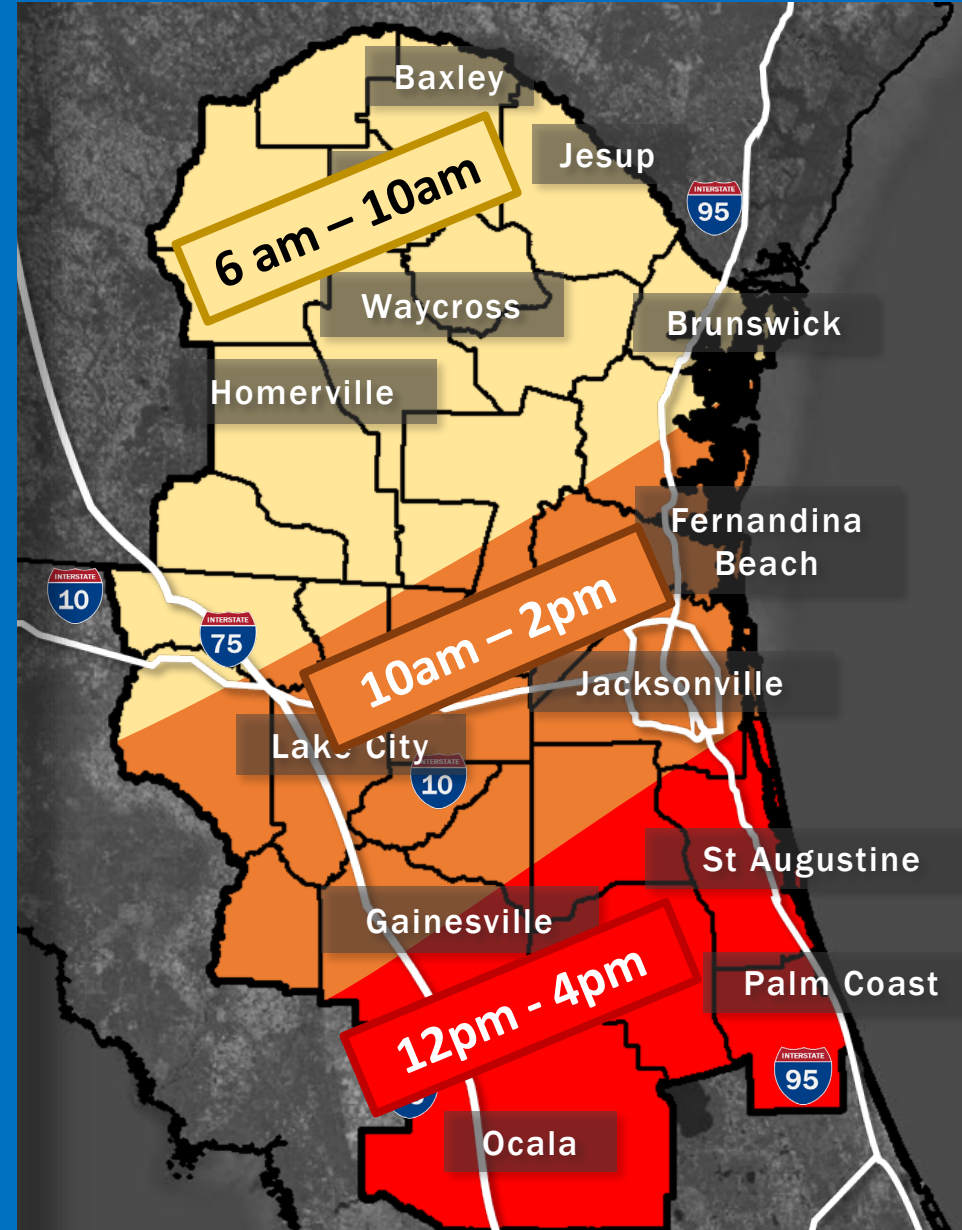

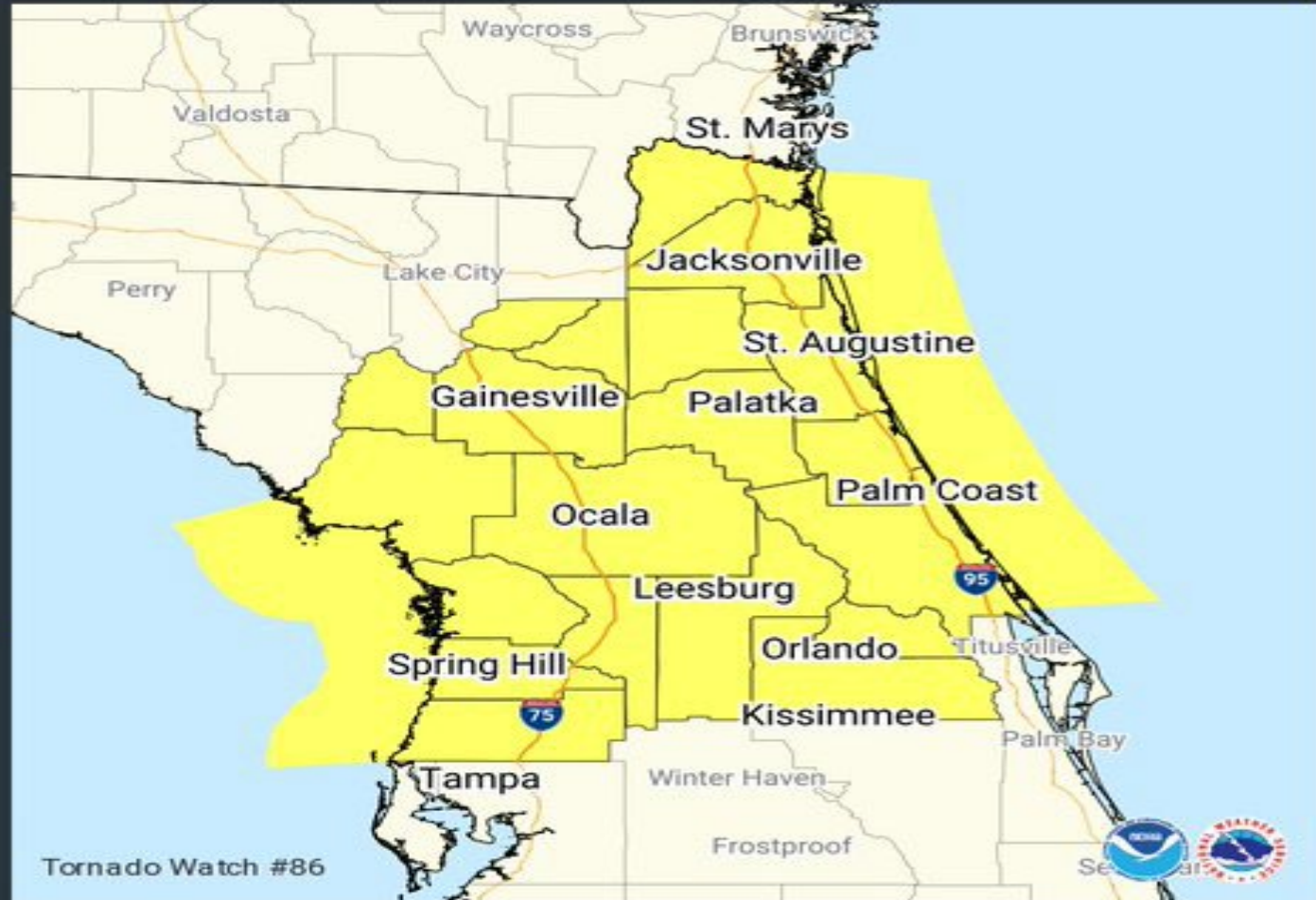

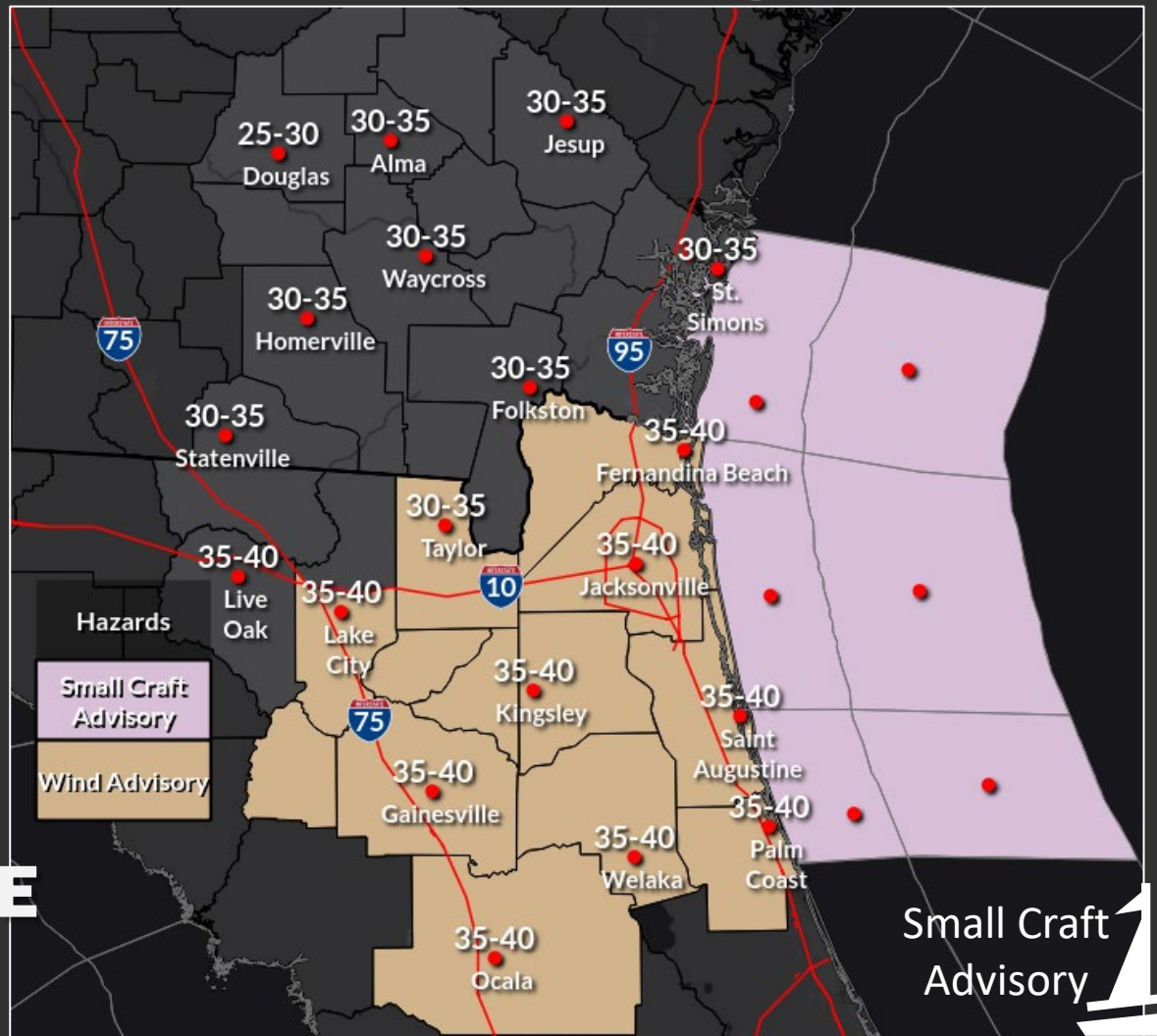
