

Interim Protocol for 2014 Elections

A. This interim protocol is dated August 25, 2014, and is for the Primary Election to be held Tuesday, August 26, 2014. It addresses short term operational issues between the City of Palm Coast and the Supervisor of Elections regarding signage related to parking at the Palm Coast Community Center.


B. This interim protocol does not alter any state statute, City charter or code provision, or the Interlocal Agreement between the City and the Supervisor. This protocol is a product of mediation efforts initiated by the County Attorney on behalf of the Flagler County Canvassing Board. This protocol is made in good faith and its implementation depends upon the reasonable actions of the parties.

C. A sufficient number of parking spaces presently exist at the Palm Coast Community Center for expected voter turnout for the last day of Early Voting, Saturday, August 23, 2014 and for Primary Election Day, August 26, 2014. If there are any problems associated with an adequate number of parking spaces for voters, the Supervisor will notify the City's Parks and Recreation Director and they shall amicably resolve any such problems.

D. Handicap parking spaces will be available to those holding permits on a first come, first served basis. To lessen the competition for such spaces on Primary Election Day, the City has significantly controlled any events scheduled at the Community Center for that day. No attachments or extra signage will be affixed to or on the handicap parking spaces at the Community Center.

E. The City agrees to meet with the County Attorney following the Primary Election to continue to work on a protocol that will govern General Election Day and its associated early voting period.
