## POLL WORKER GUIDELINES

Florida Statute 102.014 <u>REQUIRES</u> that <u>ALL</u> Poll Workers (1) attend training before <u>EVERY</u> election; (2) have the ability to read and write English; (3) be registered to vote in Flagler County and (4) be of 18 years of age. If you are not assigned to work a Precinct on Election Day or if you are not assigned by Election Staff as an Alternate, you will NOT be paid for the training class. Poll Workers are paid <u>ONLY IF THEY WORK AN ELECTION</u> <u>OR IF THEY ARE AN ASSIGNED ALTERNATE</u>.

In addition, Poll Workers <u>MUST BE WILLING TO WORK AT ANY PRECINCT IN FLAGLER COUNTY.</u> Poll Workers are required to assist in the assembly and dismantling of voting booths, which weigh up to 45 pounds each. Poll Workers are required to be able to read, write and speak the English language. They are required to be at their assigned polling location no later than 6:00 a.m. on Election Day and remain there until dismissed by the Clerk, once all work has been completed AFTER the closing of the polling place at 7:00 p.m. A Poll Worker must be able to deal efficiently, courteously, and patiently with both the public and co-workers.

New applicants may be assigned as alternate Poll Workers. Alternates could be called upon to work <u>AT ANY TIME</u> prior to the closing of the polls on Election Day. Any Poll Worker attending a Poll Worker training class that (1) does not complete the class in its entirety; (2) cannot work his or her assigned position on Election Day; or (3) is unable to accept assignment as an Alternate <u>WILL NOT BE PAID FOR ATTENDANCE AT THE TRAINING CLASS</u>.

## OATH

I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that: (1) I am currently a registered voter in Flagler County; (2) I am not a convicted felon, or if I am, that my rights relating to voting have been restored; (3) if I am duly appointed as a poll worker, a deputy, or an Alternative in Flagler County, I will faithfully perform my duties to the best of my ability and according to the election laws of the State of Florida; (4) that I have no physical disabilities that would hinder my performance at the polls; and (5) that I can read and write the English language as required by Florida law.

I certify that I am a registered voter in Flagler County, that I have no physical disabilities that would hinder my performance at the polls and that I can read and write the English language as required by Florida Law. I understand that, as a Poll Worker, I serve at the will of the Supervisor of Elections and may be removed with, or without cause.
