

Significance of the Project
A Legacy Property of Flagler County

- First state/local project to close under the landmark Florida Preservation 2000 Program
- Listed on the National Register of Historic Places as Cherokee Grove, built during Florida's Gilded Age, which is our true connection to Henry Flagler
- Only example of Adirondack Camp architecture in the State of Florida
- Anchor for the Flagler County Coastal Greenway which received the Statewide Greenways Award
- Selected by the State for the 10 year anniversary commemorative poster for the Florida Preservation 2000 Program
- Selected by the Florida Public Archeology Network as an authentic "Old Florida" historic landscape with numerous educational opportunities for public archaeology
- Property has recently hosted such professional groups as the Archeological Institute of America and the Florida Trust for Historic Preservation

Program Need – Enhancing the Visitor Experience

- An educational means of acquainting visitors with the legacy of the Princess
 - Visitor center with modern AV technology
 - Telling the story in a unique way to visitors that enhances the guided tours
 - Replacing the impossible -- the collection of furnishings assembled by the Princess

Accomplishments

- The storybooks are crafted to feel like leather bound books and are on display in the Princess Place Lodge, mounted on book stands
- Visitor Center with wall mounted flat panel monitor with video using continuous loop
 - Important milestones displayed in the Visitor's Center
 - National Register listing from the U.S. Secretary of Interior
 - State of Florida watercolor poster commemorating the Florida Preservation 2000 Program

Remaining Endeavor

- Showing the Princess' collection using museum quality photographic exhibits as the Lodge appeared during its National Register "period of significance"
- Museum quality exhibits that also display the legacy of the Princess
- Process Point One – Issue a Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") for experienced museum exhibit designers
- Process Point Two -- Contract with remaining funds to produce the exhibits
- Provide a final report upon conclusion to the State and the TDC
