1) HOW VIOLATION OCCURRED:

Violation of Condition (7) of the Order of Probation, by failing to live and remain at liberty without violating any law, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer Wolfe states that on or about 12/18/2017, the offender was in possession of a controlled substance, to-wit: Cocaine as shown by analysis of a urine sample obtained from the offender on 12/18/2017.

Circumstances: On 12/18/2017, the offender reported as instructed for weekly reporting. The offender was seen by Officer Hayes, a drug urinalysis was administered, and the offender was tested for cocaine. The drug urinalysis showed positive results for cocaine, and he denied use of any drugs. The sample was packaged in accordance with Florida Department of Corrections policy and procedure. The results were sent to Alere Toxicology for confirmation and as of 12/20/17, the results of the confirmation test have not been received.

Violation of Condition (9) of the Order of Community Control, by failing to comply with all lawful instructions given to him by the community control officer, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his community control, Officer Wolfe states that on 12/18/17, the offender was instructed to submit an accurate daily activity log for community control and the offender did fail to carry out this instruction by failing to remain confined in residence as scheduled on 12/19/17 at 2127 hours.

Violation of Modification of Supervision dated 5/8/17, Conditions (16) of the Order of Community Control, by failing to submit an hourly accounting of all activities on the designated daily activity log to his community control officer upon request, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his community control, Officer Wolfe states that on 12/19/17, the offender failed to remain confined in his approved residence per his submitted schedule, as evidenced by a home visit conducted on 12/20/17 at 2127 hours.

Violation of Modification of Supervision dated 5/8/17, Conditions (17) of the Order of Community Control, by failing to submit an hourly accounting of all activities on the designated daily activity log to his community control officer upon request, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his community control, Officer Wolfe states that on 12/19/17, the offender failed to remain confined in his approved residence per his submitted schedule, as evidenced by a home visit conducted on 12/20/17 at 2127 hours.

Circumstances: The offender submitted an Offender Schedule and Daily Activity Log for the dates of 12/16/17-12/24/17 on 12/18/17 for approval. The offender listed failed to list any activity for the day of 12/19/17 siting "home" all day. This officer attempted to locate the offender at his approved residence on 12/19/17 at 2127 hours. I was told by the owner of the residence and his current employer that he had left the residence earlier without stating where he was going. Approximately 15 minutes later, the offender called Officer W. Harrison and stated that he had left for employment reasons. The offender admitted this was not on his scheduled and he did not have prior approval to deviate from the approved schedule.

2) OFFENDER STATEMENT:

The offender called Officer W. Harrison shortly after we left his residence after discovering he was out of residence without permission. The offender stated he had left for employment reasons and admitted that this was not listed on approved schedule nor was it pre-approved by supervising officer.
