**AFFIDAVIT
VIOLATION OF SEX OFFENDER PROBATION**

Before me this day personally appeared William D. McDonough who, being first duly sworn says that Chris Thomas Miller, hereinafter referred to as the offender, was on the 21st day of April, A.D. 2006 placed on sex offender probation for the offense of Lewd or Lascivious Molestation in the Circuit Court of Flagler County, for a term of ten (10) years* in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 948, Florida Statutes.
*following forty-two (42) months DOC. Probation commenced 2/2/09.

Affiant states that the offender was instructed on the conditions of probation on 9/7/17 by Officer William D. McDonough.

Affiant further states that the offender has not properly conducted himself, but has violated the conditions of his sex offender probation in a material respect by:

LEAVING THE COUNTY WITHOUT PERMISSION

Violation of Condition (3) of the Order of Probation, by leaving his county of residence without first procuring the consent of the probation officer, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer McDonough states that on 8/27/17, the offender did leave Orange County, Florida, his county of residence, without the consent of the probation officer and did enter Osceola County, as evidenced by GPS points showing him leaving Orange County at 4:47 p.m. and returning back to Orange County at 9:28 p.m.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH CURFEW

Violation of Special Condition (16) of the Order of Probation, the offender did violate the conditions of probation by failing to comply a mandatory curfew from 10:00 p.m. until 6:00 a.m., unless otherwise specified by the court, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer McDonough states that on 5/28/17, the offender was not at his residence in order to comply with the curfew, as evidenced by his admission and GPS confirmation that he was outside the front of his home from 1:17 a.m. until 1:24 a.m. His location outside of the house could not be confirmed as he left his XT tracking device inside the home.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT TO ELECTRONIC MONITORING

Violation of Special Condition (30) of the Order of Probation, the offender did violate the conditions of probation by failing to submit to electronic monitoring, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer McDonough states that on 5/22/17 the offender refused to submit to electronic monitoring, to wit: the offender failed to maintain proper control of his XT box which resulted in a bracelet gone from 10:34 a.m. – 10:42 a.m.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT TO ELECTRONIC MONITORING

Violation of Special Condition (30) of the Order of Probation, the offender did violate the conditions of probation by failing to submit to electronic monitoring, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer McDonough states that on 5/28/17 the offender refused to submit to electronic monitoring, to wit: the offender failed to maintain proper control of his XT box which resulted in a bracelet gone from 1:17 a.m. – 1:24 a.m.

FAILURE TO SUBMIT TO ELECTRONIC MONITORING

Violation of Special Condition (30) of the Order of Probation, the offender did violate the conditions of probation by failing to submit to electronic monitoring, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated his probation, Officer McDonough states that on 9/30/17 the offender refused to submit to electronic monitoring, to wit: the offender failed to maintain proper control of his XT box which resulted in a bracelet gone from 10:46 a.m. – 10:54 a.m.
