The State has also failed to produce any evidence indicating any intoxication relating to any of the witnesses or Mr. Smith, failed to provide any witnesses, including law enforcement, who would have personal knowledge or expertise as to such. The Defense believes, based on prior indications from the State, that the State may intend to utilize the implications of racism and/or intoxication as a center theme in the instant case at trial. Any mention or implication of such, from the State or any of their

witnesses, at any point of the proceedings, would be wholly irrelevant to any material fact as it pertains to the elements of the crimes alleged, speculative, and would serve only to inflame and mislead the jury about the facts of the instant case in a substantial and unduly prejudicial manner. Therefore, any mention of such is inadmissible pursuant to the Florida Rules of Evidence 90.401-03.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant requests the exclusion of any mention of the aforementioned by the State or it's witnesses.
