who was in the hospital asked her to respond to the residence and ask Thomas to leave the residence.

At approximately 1711 hours, Deputy Ray arrived on scene as a backup officer.

At approximately 1712 hours, I arrived on scene. I noticed that Thomas had multiple backpacks on his person and two (2) cases in his right hand, one (1) of them being black in color and the other being silver in color. I noticed that Thomas appeared to be agitated and slightly confrontational with law enforcement.

It's to be noted that prior to my arrival on scene, Sergeant Weaver conducted a traffic stop on Thomas due to him riding his bicycle in the middle of the roadway of Zoun Trail. Sergeant Weaver explained to Thomas the reason for the stop and of the alleged complaint of him having drug paraphernalia. Thomas then disclosed to Sergeant Weaver that he had "rigs" in one of the backpacks and spoons. "Rig" is a slang term used to identify syringes. Please refer to Sergeant Weaver's supplement report for further information.

Deputy Ray then conducted a search of one of the backpacks. During the search, Deputy Ray located two (2) syringes and two (2) spoons within a small trash can that was inside of the backpack. I noticed that the spoons had a white in color residue on their surfaces and burnt bottoms. I noticed that one of the spoons had a piece of cotton on its surface. Based on my training and experience, I was able to identify the items to be associated with intravenous drug usage. Please refer to Deputy Ray's supplement report for further details.

The hard cases were also searched due to the illegal contraband located within one of the backpacks. The black case had a combination lock, which Thomas provided the code of 676 to unlock it. After opening the black case, multiple items of drug paraphernalia and narcotics were located within. Listed below are the items located within the case:

- 1) Four (4) used syringes.
- 2) Four (4) spoons with residue and burnt bottoms.
- 3) Multiple empty plastic baggies containing an unknown residue.
- 4) One (1) small plastic baggie containing two (2) different colored crystalline substances.
- 5) One (1) black in color plastic container with a green leafy substance.
- 6) Two (2) multi colored glass-smoking pipes containing a burnt leafy residue.

- 7) One (1) small plastic baggie with three (3) tablets with the imprint "TEVA 3279" on their surface.
- 8) One (1) digital scale.

At approximately 1729 hours, I placed Thomas under arrest and escorted him to the prisoner compartment of my patrol vehicle.

A search of the other backpack was conducted and two (2) additional digital scales were located. One (1) of the scales had an unknown white powdery residue on its surface.

While on scene, Michelle arrived and provided a sworn written statement of her observations, which led to her contacting law enforcement. According to Michelle's statement, she arrived at the aforementioned residence at approximately 1630 hours where she made contact with Thomas. Michelle stated that she asked Thomas to open the door so that she could speak with him, which he agreed. Michelle stated that she informed Thomas that she, his girlfriend, Nichole Beard, and Nichole's father, a male identified as "Mr. Steiner", wanted him to leave the property. Michelle stated that she lied to Thomas that he would be visited by police within the hour and described her actions as a "scare tactic". Michelle stated that Thomas quickly cleaned drawers and bins, which contained needles, spoons and baggies into a green in color garbage can, which he then placed into a backpack. Michelle stated that Thomas then collected his belongings and proceeded to leave the residence. Michelle stated that is when she notified law enforcement about the drug paraphernalia.

I then transported Thomas to the Flagler County Detention Facility.

Upon my arrival at the Flagler County Detention Facility, I conducted a field narcotics test of the green leafy substance within the black plastic container using a Lynn Peavey Quick Check Marijuana Kit, which yielded presumptive positive results for the presence of marijuana. The approximate weight of the substance was one (1) gram.

I then conducted a field narcotics test of the crystalline substance inside the small plastic baggie using a Lynn Peavey Quick Check Methamphetamine Kit, which yielded presumptive positive results for the presence of methamphetamines. The approximate weight of the substance was one (1) gram.

I then conducted a field narcotics test of the crystalline coated cotton swab that was caked on one (1) of the spoons located within the black case using a Lynn Peavey Quick Check Methamphetamine Kit, which yielded presumptive positive results for the presence of methamphetamines.

All items of evidentiary value were submitted into evidence at the Flagler County Sheriff's Office: Operations Center.

The small plastic baggie containing the two (2) different colored crystalline substance will be submitted to the Florida Department of Law Enforcement (FDLE) Laboratory for further chemical analysis.
