The undersigned certifies and swears that there is probable cause to believe the above-named defendant, on the 10 th - 11 th day of January, 2006, at approximately 8:00 pm - 11:50 <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> a.m. <input type="checkbox"/> p.m. at 18 Clarendon Court South Palm Coast, FL within Flagler County, violated the law and did then and there: Murder; The unlawful killing of a human being: When perpetrated from a premeditated design to effect the death of the person killed or any human being; To wit: On 01-11-06, at approximately 11:55 AM, the Flagler County Sheriff's Office dispatch center received a 911 call from a neighbor who resides at 16 Clarendon Court South and advised the resident of 18 Clarendon Court South appeared dead with a knife protruding from his chest. Deputy Brandon Fiveash responded to 18 Clarendon Court South in reference to the aforementioned incident. Upon arrival Deputy Fiveash and Cpl. Bray checked the residence and determined that a homicide occurred. In the presence of Cpl. Bray Caryn Prather, Paramedic, pronounced the victim, Jack Dunn, deceased at 12:08 P.M. While at 18 Clarendon Court South I interviewed Maria Munoz, caretaker. Munoz advised that she left 18 Clarendon Court South at approximately 8:00 PM on 01-10-05. Munoz stated when she left the residence the victim and defendant, Richard Frizzi Dunn remained. Munoz stated the defendant was in his bedroom wearing a white pair of sweatpants and a white t-shirt. Munoz stated that the defendant's bedroom is located at the south east corner of the residence. Sally Dunn, daughter in law to the victim, indicated the defendant has a mental condition, she is afraid of him and the defendant threatened her in the past with bodily harm. The defendant upon my request agreed to respond to the Criminal Investigations Division for the purpose of an interview. During an audio/video taped post Miranda interview same denied any knowledge of his father's death. Pursuant to a search warrant for 18 Clarendon Court South signed by the Honorable Richard O. Watson, Senior Circuit Court, Seventh Judicial Circuit,


Flagler County, FL a pair of white sweatpants with a substance which appears to be blood was found on the mattress in the defendant's bedroom. A white t-shirt with a substance which appears to be blood was found in the hallway just outside the defendant's bedroom.

The victim was located in the hallway between the kitchen and laundry room lying on his back. Observation of the victim showed what appeared to be a knife in the chest. There was what appeared to be a fork lodged in the victim's neck area as well as an additional possible fork in the groin area. On the left forearm there was a laceration, one to two inches in length. In the victim's left eye there was what appeared to be some type of key. In victim's right eye, nostrils and mouth there was a substance lodged, possibly smokeless tobacco. On and around the body there was what appeared to be raisins, vitamins and pretzels. On the victim's chest, next to the knife protruding from the chest, there was what appeared to be a biscuit with a bite taken out of it. On the victims upper abdomen was what a appeared to be a small mantle clock. In the victim's right hand was a can of smokeless tobacco. Lying next to the can of smokeless tobacco was an unknown pill container.

Upon observing the scene a substance which appeared to be blood was found in the kitchen, hallway, laundryroom and master bedroom. In the kitchen the wall telephone appeared to be ripped out of the wall and lying on the floor. In the master bedroom was a glass top table which showed signs of a struggle. Further examination of the glass top table showed a substance which appeared to be blood. In the following areas items were in disarray; livingroom and hallway to the defendant's bedroom.

Investigator Lopez, Medical Examiners Office responded to assist with the examination of the victim. Investigator Lopez indicated multiple stab wounds to the victim's chest.

Based upon the totality of the aforementioned circumstances which were discussed with S.A.O. Steve Nelson and members of the Homicide Investigations Unit, the defendant was placed under arrest.
