The green tarp used outside on the playground for shade was not anchored properly to pole. One side of the tarp was clipped to the iron fence due to it came loose from the pole. Counselor recommended to replace clip and re-anchor back to pole. The property maintenance man was called and he replaced the clip and re-anchored tarp back to the pole at time of inspection.
