As you are aware, you were placed on leave under the Family Medical Leave Act (FMLA) on August 22, 2023, per your request and through your health care provider's certification. Your FMLA leave was exhausted November 14, 2023. You then requested and were granted a Leave of Absence through November 22, 2023. You were expected to report to work on Monday, November 27, 2023.

On November 26, 2023, you requested additional FMLA leave through Anita Stoker, Benefits & Wellness Manager via email. On November 28, 2023, Pamela Wu, Human Resources Director responded to your request denying additional FMLA leave as the 12 weeks of leave permitted under the Act had already been exhausted and she advised you that you were expected to have returned to work November 27, 2023.

Today is the seventh consecutive workday that you have failed to report to work and have failed to contact me or the Human Resources office. Effective immediately the County considers you to have resigned from the County Engineer position with the Flagler County Board of County Commissioners.
