

SEARCH WARRANT

IN THE CIRCUIT COURT, SEVENTH JUDICIAL CIRCUIT, IN AND FOR FLAGLER COUNTY, FLORIDA.

IN THE NAME OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA, TO ALL AND SINGULAR: To all the State Attorney Investigators of the Honorable R.J. Larizza, State Attorney for the Seventh Judicial Circuit, State of Florida, and to Rick Staly, Sheriff of Flagler County, and his Lawful Deputies; The commissioner of the Florida Department of Law Enforcement, or any of his Duly constituted special agents and to Wayne Ivey, Sheriff of Brevard County, and his lawful deputies.

WHEREAS, complaint on oath and in writing supported by affidavit of Jodi Glasgow, a Detective with the Flagler County Sheriffs Office, and a credible witness, has this day been made before me the undersigned Judge of the Circuit Court, in and for Flagler County, Florida.

WHEREAS, said facts know to me and considered by me have caused me to certify and find that said facts set forth in said affidavit show and constitute probable cause for the issuance of this warrant, and the Court being satisfied of this existence of said grounds set forth in the affidavit and that the laws of the State of Florida have been and are being violated in or on a certain dwelling residence in Flagler County, Florida, being known and described as follows:

80 Pine Tree Lane, Bunnell, Flagler County, Florida 32110

The residence is a white double wide mobile home with blue window shutters. There is a wooden stair case leading up to the front door where the number "80" is on the door frame in black numbers. When facing the residence there is a small wooden fence to the right of the staircase that wraps around to the porch area. There is a screened in porch on the right end of the residence. When facing the residence to the left is the dirt driveway that leads to as detached shed with two doors. In between the shed and the residence is a chain link fence with a swinging gate.

The residence is located at 80 Pine Tree Lane, Bunnell, Flagler County, Florida 32110. To locate this residence starting from the intersection of State Road 11 and County Road 304 (Cody's Corner), travel west on County Road 304 for approximately 7.7 miles toward County Road 305, turn right on County Road 305 traveling north for approximately 4.6 miles. Turn right onto Quarter Horse lane for approximately 0.5 miles, turn left onto Pine Tree lane for approximately 394 feet. The residence will be located on the right side of the road.

Said property being the dwelling and curtilage thereof is occupied by and under the control of Dorothy Singer. This information was verified through the Florida Department of Motor Vehicles, recent law enforcement contact and interview with landlord

And there is now being kept in or on the above described property and the curtilage thereof the following items relating to the crime of Murder in violation of Section 782.04, Florida Statutes:

- The body of Charles Singer




- Cellular telephone belonging to Charles Singer (phone number: 561-891-6593)

NOW THEREFORE, you or either of you, with such lawful assistance as may be necessary, are hereby commanded in the name of the State of Florida, in the daytime or in the nighttime as the exigencies of the occasion may demand or require or on Sunday, to serve this warrant upon the person(s) in charge of or living upon or within the place or things searched pursuant to this warrant, and in the absence of any such person, to leave the duplicate warrant at the place or thing searched pursuant to this warrant, and to enter the described dwelling, curtilage, structures, and vehicles or persons thereof and to diligently search for certain evidence relating to the crime of Murder in violation of Section 782.04, Florida Statutes, or the means by which a felony has been committed, or evidence relevant to proving said felony, and if the specified property sought herein, or any part thereof, is found within the place for things you have been directed to search then you are commanded to seize and secure the specified property, to prepare in duplicate a verified inventory and receipt for the specified property seized, to deliver a duplicate of the verified copy inventory and receipt to the person(s) named in this warrant, or in his or her absence to the person in charge of, or living, upon or within the place or thing searched pursuant to this warrant, and in the absence of any such person, to leave the duplicate inventory and receipt at the place or thing searched pursuant to this warrant.

You are further commanded to bring any person arrested in connection with the specified property seized before me or some other Court having jurisdiction of the violation(s) of the Law(s) of The State of Florida as recited in this warrant, and to forthwith make a sworn return of your doings upon executing this warrant and to return and file the original of this warrant, the original affidavit for this warrant, and the original inventory within 10 days from the date of issuance of this warrant.
