Dear Mr. Cameron:

We are pleased to present you with this report of the spatial needs assessment for the Sheriff's Office relative to a new Administration and Operations Facility to be located in Palm Coast. We submit this report to you with a focus on addressing the Sheriff's Office's current and future spatial needs and to ensure that appropriate space has been planned for efficiency and to meet the standards for a modern law enforcement facility.

We understand the need for this report as the Sheriff's Office has moved out of the renovated headquarters facility in Bunnell due to existing building issues and is now in temporary space in county offices.

The Center for Public Safety (CPS) was pleased to work with the Sheriff's Office, in collaboration with the Sheriff and his command staff.

Firm Background and Experience:

Since its inception, CPS has focused on serving the needs of city and county governments and the public safety sector, specifically in law enforcement, training and emergency services. With our project experience, we have become recognized as one of the most highly specialized firms in this unique and critical facility planning area.

CPS focuses entirely on serving the need of local governmental entities. CPS achieves this through several means. First, we have hosted facility planning seminars for the past 19 years. The seminar is designed to educate local officials on the process, methodology and means by which to effectively plan, fund, design and construct facilities relevant to their mission.

We also utilize our experience in space planning to assist our clients with preliminary and detailed spatial needs studies as well as conduct feasibility and site selection studies.

Senior staff have worked on 221 political, candidate, referendum and bond efforts since the 1992 election cycle. We assisted our clients in crafting educational outreach efforts and directed databases, direct mail, vote by mail efforts, and other means of effective resident and voter communication.

Lastly, we strive to assist our clients in identifying, writing and obtaining additional project funding through public and private grants, financial institution lending, public/private partnerships and other means.

Project Methodology:

To be successful in undertaking a project of this magnitude we utilize a proprietary methodology CPS developed specifically for county and public safety projects.

We track and maintain data for counties, municipalities, law enforcement and public safety departments in such areas as square footage, costs per square foot, regional construction costs and cost anomalies, facility survivability needs, policing methods as well as take into account specialized units, vehicles, weather and other natural design requirements to focus narrowly on the individualized needs of our clients.

Community characteristics are also taken into account. According to the University of Florida's Bureau of Economics and Business Resources' Florida Population Studies, Bulletin 183, Flagler County will continue to see population growth every five years. By the year 2045, estimates of the county's population range from a low of 123,000 to a high of 198,200.

The US Census Bureau in May 2018 released its City/Town Population and Housing Unit Estimates and stated that Flagler County and the City of Palm Coast were growing faster than the nation and the State of Florida and in most cases faster than neighboring counties or communities. In fact, Flagler County was growing was adding population almost 10% faster than the nation as a whole.

The estimates may vary but the county will continue to grow and no population loss is anticipated. As the population grows, calls for law enforcement service will grow as well.

Thus, Flagler County and the Sheriff's Office are undertaking this study and project at the right time to plan accordingly for the next few decades.

This project started with the design of a spatial needs questionnaire which was distributed to the Sheriff's command staff. Personal interviews were then conducted over several days to meet with members of all areas in the Sheriff's Office to better understand what they do, the population they serve and how a more efficient use of space may enhance the quality of service provided to the residents of Flagler County.

Using the questionnaire results and along with information from individual interviews and exterior and interior facility examinations and site visits, we were able to utilize the data and our process to derive current and future spatial need projections.

The goal is to accurately project spatial need years into the future to ensure that growth and changing needs are accommodated with minimal disruption to future logistics and operations.

Spatial Need:

The issues and challenges with the former Sheriff's Office headquarters facility are well documented. The county is now in the position where the spatial needs of the Sheriff's Office must be addressed.

The county has identified the future project location in Palm Coast on a county owned site with an existing library at the intersection of Palm Coast Parkway, NW and Belle Terre Parkway.

This project is also unique in that the project envisions encapsulating four facilities into one structure or on one site. These include the Sheriff's administration and operations facility, a county information technology office, workspace and storage facility, a real time crime center and a Sheriff's Office District II facility.

Because the City of Palm Coast contracts with the Sheriff's Office to provide law enforcement services, the DII element is akin to adding an entire municipal law enforcement facility into the project. It should be noted that the IT department serves the Sheriff's Office and the entire county as well as the municipalities of Palm Coast and Flagler Beach.

The Sheriff's correctional responsibilities were not part of this project nor is the future training space for deputies for weapons certification, vehicle training or classrooms at a training facility.

This study projects spatial needs for the next two decades. Almost every area of service will growth with the possible exception of records. While many jurisdictions are moving to digitize records, statutory requirements remain and some records (and their originals) must be kept for long periods of time if not indefinitely.

Some areas of services such as patrol, investigations, community outreach and information technology will experience growth in services and personnel.

Existing Conditions:

As previously written, the former Sheriff's Administration facility has been the focus of media reports over the past few years and much has been written about the facility and its conditions. This document does not need to expound on the issues of the former facility as they are well known to the county, its decision makers and administration.

The Sheriff's Office was moved out of its space and now temporarily occupies county space in its Bunnell county-owned facilities. The Sheriff's Office is currently working out of approximately 8% of what modern law enforcement standard would deem necessary in order to be fully operational.

Areas of Critical Concern:

Public Access Areas:

The public access areas like parking, the building façade, the lobby and multi-purpose space must be open and friendly areas but must provide for the safety and security of city and public safety personnel.

Recent incidents like the tragic shooting of the Sheriff's deputies in Gilchrist County illustrate the critical need to protect staff and the public. This project envisions a welcoming public access space and natural light filled lobby. In this lobby space, residents can file or receive reports from the records department, can access the COPs office and programs, School Resource Deputies, the youth athletic league, community outreach offices and the media can be briefed by the Sheriff on important events and developments.

The spatial projections also include multi-purpose space for community events, classes, training, citizen academies, awards and promotional ceremonies and more. This space, as envisioned will be one of the most used spaces in the facility.

While welcoming and inviting, the spaces must be secure and equally protect staff and civilian guests. Secure zones keep the public from the interior of the Sheriff's Office while allowing access to critical services and programs.

Sally Port and Secure Holding and Interview Areas:

Bringing suspects into a facility is dangerous and can have tragic consequences for those facilities which do not allow for the safe transfer, holding and movement of suspects and especially for those departments with no sally port. The sally port is a secured space where suspects can be brought into or out of the facility into waiting vehicles for transportation to medical, judicial or correctional facilities.

Suspects and detainees in custody are the responsibility of the Sheriff's Office (S.O.) and space specifically designed with them in mind are present in the lobby of the future facility as well as in the patrol and criminal investigations area of the building.

These secure interview rooms in the lobby serve several purposes in addition to being secure spaces. Victims and family members coming to the facility can be moved into more private spaces off the lobby floor. These spaces can serve as private places for S.O. employees can speak with visitors, where fingerprints can be made, where evidence technicians can return items to civilians and the larger room can provide a short-term (2-4 hours) secure space for victims of domestic abuse or violence.

Evidence, Processing and Storage Areas:

Often the Achilles heel of many public safety entities is its evidence drop off, processing and storage areas. Maintaining the "chain of custody" and meeting statutorily mandated rules and laws regarding evidence are very difficult for many entities without the property facilities.

Entry into this area must have its own security system to restrict access in spaces that store evidence including weapons, narcotics, cash and valuables. This area must be under constant video surveillance and should be contained within a law enforcement facility to prevent unauthorized access. This area has a higher cost than other spaces due to these requirements for security and storage.

Building Security and Facility Survivability:

Almost without exception, nowhere in our nation is immune from natural storms and disasters. Changing climatic patterns and weather conditions have seen storms and natural events with greater intensity than in past years. The loss of life and damage to property from these events has increased even in the face of greater understanding of how these weather conditions occur, form, move and dissipate.

The opportunity to plan and design facilities or even parts of facilities to meet, match and anticipate climatic activity can protect your facility and the personnel that work there.

No matter where a new facility is located a critical need remains and that is to have a safe, survivable facility that protects its occupants and employees. Windows and glass need to be ballistic rated glazing systems. Doors and building materials must be specified to create a secure building envelope. The facility needs to have back up redundancy built into its critical, water, power, sewer and technology systems.

Items such as a back-generator capable of keeping the facility online in a power outage must be situated and protected from both the elements and any potential man-made disaster. Perimeter security and the ability to separate public vehicles from department vehicles and additional rolling stock are paramount.

As a critical first responder facility, this facility along with emergency operations and communications represent the highest need for survivability for any county service. There is a correlated cost to any structure designed to withstand man-made or natural events and maintain operations before, during and after any situation. As a coastal county, hurricane protection must be a consideration.

Site Requirements:

The spatial needs assessment determined the Sheriff's Office's functional requirements as well as the initial square footage for a new facility. Knowing the size of the immediate footprint and how the Sheriff's Office functions on a daily basis determines the minimum acreage needed as potential properties and land is considered.

This exercise also defined space needs for future expansions as technology continues to evolve, the needs of the office spatial expansions for daily operational needs as the community's population and service needs change. The property identified as the site must provide for the following characteristics.

Even though the site for a new facility has been determined, it's very important for this site to enhance the functions of the Sheriff's Office's daily routine rather than create obstacles that have to be accepted. The facility site considerations are as follows.

- Perimeter and site security designed to protect staff, the public and the facility in the event of a natural disaster, storm or act of terrorism
- Parking to accommodate city personnel and the public
- Ample space for vehicular traffic movement around facility
- Provisions for secured parking for staff and for additional rolling stock
- · Area for fleet maintenance and storage or impound vehicles if possible or desired
- Ample parking for the additional entities, the public and media during increased activity
- The site must provide for storm water management systems and green space
- Provide a perimeter area for either buffers required by zoning or appropriate landscaping for the surrounding property
- Anticipated growth will require a site to be large enough to accommodate expansions if the project takes a phased approach
- Master plan for the capability to add to the facility, if possible
- Adequate arterial access and egress for vehicles.

Green Building Design and Systems:

Should the County adopt a Green Building Program; which is a code mandate to assure construction of resilient, sustainable buildings in the community. The Green Building Program adapts provisions of the International Green Construction Code (IGCC). This is consistent with the initiatives of other progressive municipalities.

The U.S. Department of Energy reports: "buildings in the United States consume more than 30% of our energy supply and construction, accounts for 48% of all greenhouse emissions." Due to the prevailing energy consumption, the GSA and many other agencies are promoting government buildings to be more sustainable. In New York City, former Mayor Bloomberg signed into law the "New York Green City Building Act, which requires that non-residential projects costing \$2 million or more meet Silver LEED standards." The City of Miami, Florida enacted its Miami 21 Plan, which promotes sustainable urban development. These examples are growing in number, as governments are leading by example, and recognizing the many tangible benefits of sustainable design.

Our clients have found it important to implement sustainable strategies. The techniques utilized on several projects have returned upfront costs in operational savings during the life of the building, as well as providing immeasurable value associated with a quality working environment. CPS has also assisted in planning several LEED certified law enforcement facilities.

Among the many design strategies required of any Green Building Program is day lighting and sun shading strategies, which are reliable design strategies, common "good design practice", and, in the case of recent projects, the payback can be as little as 10-16 months for such techniques. It should be noted, however, that to gain full savings and benefits of our day lighting strategy, it must be combined with the use of efficient lighting, daylight sensors, HVAC, and energy monitoring by the user group.

A fictional example would be an Electric Utility Facility as a case study for cost benefit analysis. The building is a two-story, 33,000 gross square foot facility with an established base budget of \$3.4 million. To reduce long-term operational costs, we could suggest the following sustainable technologies which were above the basic state's Building Energy Code.

Green building design strategies that would be recommended as enhancements to code requirements, resulted in a 5.4% premium cost and a total budget of \$3.6 million. Primary considerations could be:

- HVAC chilled water system
- T8 energy efficient indirect light fixtures
- Enhanced rigid insulation for all exterior walls and roofs
- High reflective single ply roofing membrane
- High energy efficient insulated glazing (windows)
- Aluminum solar shading elements for all exposed windows
- Roof top day-light shafts
- Note: the cost savings for the on-site chilled water well to supply the chillers with pre-cooled water is not included in this analysis.

The total premium cost for the strategies listed above would be approximately 5.4% above the established base budget – equating to \$5.60 per square foot of additional cost.

To further explore the cost of sustainable technologies we would like to offer recognized statistics on the subject. In general, the cost to be "green" varies based on the extent of strategies utilized. A fully sustainable building would consider not only day lighting and shading, but would include appropriate site orientation, water efficiency, energy use, materials and resources, indoor air quality, and

other innovative technologies. Implementing green building strategies of this extent can lead to a 2-4% increase in construction costs, as compared to a building which was not designed with these criteria in mind. However, construction material and systems suppliers have recently introduced efficient products that have reduced costs.

Importantly, we can also design a highly efficient building without the LEED certification, which requires an extensive documentation and application process. In return for implementing sustainable strategies, we achieve a life cycle payback in a reduced time frame.

The basic premise is that the project design will implement a Green Building Program, to the fullest extent possible, with cost-effective strategies that will improve the workplace environment while reducing long term facility operational costs. Governmental buildings, in that respect, should be held to a higher standard and could be highly visible examples of Green Architecture; examples that encourage similar commitments by the private sector.

Conclusion and Recommendations:

The objective of this report is to conduct an analysis of the Sheriff's Office relative to their current and future space needs.

To undertake this project, we were able to apply our experience and background in the examination, planning and design of public safety facilities.

Questionnaires were created, distributed, completed and received from Sheriff's Office personnel.

The data obtained from the questionnaire responses was enhanced by team members conducting intensive and interactive interviews with command staff and members of the Sheriff's Office representing all areas and levels of service throughout the county.

We then applied this information to proprietary spatial standards to determine current need in year 2020 would equate to **76,765** square feet with an additional **4,828** square feet to meet additional demand for space in future years.

The projection for the department to meet its space needs until the year 2030 would be a total of **81,593** square feet.

In conclusion, we want to express our team's gratitude to Sheriff Rick Staly, Chief of Staff Mark Strobridge, Commander Bob Weber and other employees with which we met and received their input and for their assistance without which this report would not have been possible.

Once the spatial projections have been completed, a cost evaluation is performed for the building and the site so that project costs can be determined and the appropriate individuals have information necessary to make funding decisions moving forward. It should be noted that many projects examine and review and evaluate multiple sites for their potential future use using a set of criteria we have developed over the thirty years.

For this project, a site has been determined. The county is in the enviable position of holding title to the site and no acquisition costs are needed. In addition, a county library is on site and adjacent to the area anticipated for the Sheriff's Office's administration and operations facility. The site is situated between two main aerial traffic routes and the necessary infrastructure items are already in place. These include water, sanitary, electrical, communications and technology. None of which have to be brought to the site further reducing site costs.

The county does not have to demolish any existing structures, there are no anticipated pre-existing environmental issues and the topography of the site will not require extensive site work. The site has plenty of acreage for the proposed building plan and ancillary space needs.

The cost estimates are just that, estimates. Final costs will be determined by the selected design team in the future and at a time in the project dependent upon the county's selection of a construction delivery method. We do, however, strive to provide line item identification of costs to further enhance the clients understanding of what the project will cost and why and where critical dollars will be spent. These line items include the following;

Building construction cost per square foot (SF)

Site development cost which will include;

- Utilities (water, sanitary, electrical, telecommunications and cabling)
- Grading, fill and drainage
- Parking, paving and walkways
- Landscaping and irrigation
- Fencing, gates and barriers

Technology systems cost which will include;

- Voice-data and structured cabling
- Audio / visual systems

Security systems

Furniture, Fixtures and Equipment (FF&E)

Soft costs which include all architectural and engineering fees, survey costs, geotechnical costs and construction administration which run about 9% to 11% but will be counted at 9.25% for this project.

It is important to note that the spatial projections are for current need (year 2020) and project future need to the year 2040. As Flagler County is a growing community and the US Census Bureau and the University of Florida expect the population to continue to rise with no expectation of a population decline, the increase in call for service, along with changes in technology and their impact on the built environment dictate growth in areas of the facility. These areas of possible growth are reflected in future years.

The spatial projections represent a careful consideration of Sheriff's Office operations, services and needs. This report provides a room by room spatial projection which does not include excess space. Each of these spaces can be accounted for in terms of need and justified currently and in the near future.

Cost projections were based on our experience with similar projects across the nation with the Center for Public Safety as a prime firm under contract and serving as a consultant to other firms. We spoke with professionals in the design fields of architectural and engineering. We looked at several projects for public safety facilities across several counties in Central Florida focusing on projects of a similar type in close geographic proximity to Flagler County.
