

Florida's October Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 3.3 percent in October 2024, unchanged from the September 2024 rate, and up 0.2 percentage point from a year ago. There were 369,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 11,029,000. The U.S. seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 4.1 percent in October.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 9,946,000 in October 2024, a decrease of 38,000 jobs (-0.4 percent) over the month. Please see the technical note on page 2 on the impacts that Hurricanes Helene and Milton had on the October 2024 economic data. The state gained 133,200 jobs over the year, an increase of 1.4 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs rose 1.4 percent over the year.

Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Eight of ten major industries experienced positive over-the-year job growth in October.
- The industries gaining jobs over the year included education and health services (+42,300 jobs, +2.8 percent); construction (+27,700 jobs, +4.4 percent); total government (+25,600 jobs, +2.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (+21,500 jobs, +1.1 percent); other services (+13,800 jobs, +3.7 percent); leisure and hospitality (+5,900 jobs, +0.5 percent); professional and business services (+4,400 jobs, +0.3 percent); and information (+900 jobs, +0.6 percent).
- The industries losing jobs over the year were manufacturing (-3,500 jobs, -0.8 percent) and financial activities (-5,500 jobs, -0.8 percent).

Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In October 2024, Miami-Dade County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (2.2 percent), followed by Monroe County (2.3 percent), and Gulf County (3.1 percent each).
- Citrus County had the highest unemployment rate (5.6 percent) in Florida in October 2024, followed by Hamilton County (5.2 percent), and Sumter County (5.1 percent).

Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

• In October 2024, all 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job gains. The areas with the largest gains were the Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall MD (+21,500 jobs, +1.6 percent), followed by the Fort Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach MD (+15,500 jobs, +1.7 percent), and the Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford MSA (+9,800 jobs, +0.7 percent).

October 2024 is the first month in which the economic data reflect the impacts of Hurricanes Helene and Milton on Florida's labor market. Helene made landfall after the September survey period, but before data collection began for October, while Hurricane Milton made landfall during the week for which employers were asked to report on payroll employment. It is likely that payroll employment estimates in many industries and Metropolitan Statistical Areas were affected by the hurricanes.

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Commerce.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
