


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#### Florida's December Employment Figures Released

Florida's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 6.1 percent in December 2020, down 0.2 percentage point from the revised November 2020 rate, and up 3.2 percentage points from a year ago. There were 614,000 jobless Floridians out of a labor force of 10,143,000. The U.S. unemployment rate was 6.7 percent in December.

Florida's seasonally adjusted total nonagricultural employment was 8,612,200 in December 2020, an increase of 16,800 jobs (+0.2 percent) over the month. The state lost 419,200 jobs over the year, a decrease of 4.6 percent. Nationally, the number of jobs fell 6.2 percent over the year.

December labor statistics reflect the continued effects of COVID-19 and the efforts to reopen businesses and services.

#### Florida's Nonagricultural Employment by Industry (Seasonally Adjusted)

- Florida lost 1,178,100 jobs from February to April 2020 and has since gained back over half of the jobs lost (+718,700 jobs).
- The number of jobs in Florida was 8,612,200 in December 2020, down 419,200 jobs compared to a year ago. All ten major industries experienced negative over-the-year job growth in December.
- The industry losing the most jobs over the year was leisure and hospitality (-197,000 jobs, -15.5 percent).

Other industries losing jobs over the year included professional and business services (-52,000 jobs, -3.7 percent); total government (-47,900, -4.3 percent); trade, transportation, and utilities (-43,300 jobs, -2.4 percent); education and health services (-29,100 jobs, -2.1 percent); other services (-23,400 jobs, -6.6 percent); information (-12,100 jobs, -8.8 percent); construction (-9,900 jobs, -1.7 percent); manufacturing (-4,400 jobs, -1.1 percent); and financial activities (-100 jobs, less than 0.1 percent decrease).

#### Local Area Unemployment Statistics (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2020, St. Johns County and Wakulla County had the state's lowest unemployment rate (3.6 percent each), followed by Monroe County (3.8 percent), and Clay County and DeSoto County (3.9 percent each).
- Osceola County had the highest unemployment rate (8.7 percent) in Florida in December 2020, followed by Miami-Dade County (7.3 percent), Orange County and Putnam County (7.2 percent each), and Gadsden County and Hamilton County (7.0 percent each).

#### Area Nonagricultural Employment (Not Seasonally Adjusted)

- In December 2020, 21 out of 24 metro areas in Florida had over-the-year job losses. The areas with the largest losses were Orlando-Kissimmee-Sanford (-130,000 jobs, -9.6 percent), Miami-Miami Beach-Kendall (-69,200 jobs, -5.6 percent), and Fort Lauderdale-Pompano Beach-Deerfield Beach (-63,200 jobs, -7.2 percent).
- Three metro areas in Florida experienced an over-the-year job gain in December 2020: Ocala (1,900 jobs, +1.8 percent), Sebring (+300 jobs +1.1 percent), and The Villages (+300 jobs, +0.9 percent).

The unemployment and job growth rates are estimates, which are primarily based on surveys created and mandated by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics in cooperation with the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity.

The unemployment rate is derived from Florida household surveys conducted by the U.S. Census Bureau under contract with the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics. The job growth rate is derived from Florida employer surveys conducted by the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Both estimates are revised on a monthly basis. In addition, these estimates are benchmarked (revised) annually based on actual counts from Florida's Reemployment Assistance tax records and other data.
