Dear Judge Perkins,

In accordance with instructions from this court authorizing the use of a technical violation notification letter to report specific violations, this letter is to notify the court that the above offender is in violation of the condition(s) of supervision noted below. Please advise below whether you agree with the department's recommendation to continue supervision with no further action or if you would like additional action. The department will continue supervision with no further action on this violation unless otherwise directed by the court within fourteen (14) days.

Violation of Condition (6) of the Order of Drug Offender Probation, by associating with any person engaged in criminal activity, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated her probation, Officer Casey Sherrill states that on 05/23/2020, the offender did associate with Jacob Baer who was engaged in criminal activity, as evidenced by his arrest for Knowingly Driving While License Suspended or Revoked by Flagler County Sheriff's Office.

Violation of Condition (7) of the Order of Drug Offender Probation, by using intoxicants to excess or possessing any drugs or narcotics, unless prescribed by a physician, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated her probation, Officer Casey Sherrill states that the offender was in possession of a glass pipe and Marijuana on 05/23/2020, as told to this officer by Corporal Gamarra, Flagler County Sheriff's Office, on 05/26/2020.

Violation of Special Condition (15b) of the Order of Drug Offender Probation, by associating with anyone who is illegally using drugs or consuming alcohol, and as grounds for belief that the offender violated her probation, Officer Casey Sherrill states that the offender did associate with Jacob Baer on 05/23/2020 who was illegally consuming alcohol, as evidenced by his traffic citation for Open Container of Alcohol in/on Motor Vehicle in Operation (Driver), issued by Flagler County Sheriff's Office.

Circumstances: On 05/23/2020, Jacob Baer was driving the offender's vehicle when a traffic stop was initiated by Flagler County Sheriff's Office. Jacob Baer was subsequently found to be in possession of an open container of beer and was cited with a traffic citation. Furthermore, he was arrested for driving while his license was suspended or revoked. A glass pipe and marijuana were located in her vehicle, but neither the offender or Jacob Baer were charged with possession. The offender's 11-month-old child was also present in the car during this incident. The offender has expressed her remorse to this officer as well as the Drug Court team, and the letter she wrote to the courts is attached to this report.

Officer Comments: This officer respectfully recommends that the offender be appropriately sanctioned in the Flagler County Drug Court program as this is her first violation of probation for this case.

On May 23,2020 I made the decision to take my youngest daughter Kaya with me to see her father Jacob Baer knowing he is not allowed to see her without proper supervision. The reason I went to see him was because I found out that I am pregnant with his child. I thought if I told him that I could convince him to do better and to continue to work with DCF to complete his case plan so we could eventually have our family back together. We were at the gas station and I was about to take him to a friend's house and go home. I began to feel ill, so I asked Jacob to drive me home knowing he had been drinking, also knowing he doesn't have a license. We ended up being pulled over and the officers found two empty beer cans Jacob had left in the car, also they found marijuana and two smoking devices that belong to Jacob. After the search Jacob was taken to jail and luckily, I was able to drive home with my daughter. I could have went to jail right then and there and lost my vehicle for letting him drive without a proper driver's license. Also, I could have been taken for endangering my daughters' life. I can admit I was not thinking clearly, all I was thinking about was raising another child by myself. There is no excuse for my behavior and bad decisions. I may lose my children again and go to jail. I have messed up every bit of progress I have made. I have lost the trust of people I respect, that were proud of me and everything I was doing. I am fully responsible and ready to deal with the repercussions of my actions. Also, I do want everyone to know that I have kept my sobriety throughout all of this. I have not had the urge to pick up a drink or use any drugs. Hopefully I will get the chance to prove that nothing like this will ever happen again. I need my kids, drug court and my job, I am truly sorry for my actions.

05/23/2020 : 17:37:12 flagso\fgamarra Narrative: I left a voicemail with Amber's probation officer in reference to the stop, and circumstances of the stop.

05/23/2020 : 17:36:48 flagso\fgamarra Narrative: I stoodby for officer safety while Deputy Gossett ran the driver and passenger's information for wants/warrants. The driver and 10-15 advised that his GA DL was suspended in reference to DUI. I observed an open container of Busch Lite (blue can) by his feet. I asked for the can and he handed it to me. It was still cool to the touch and still contained beer (an alcoholic beverage). He advised that he had drank one beer, over 4 hours ago; however had just stated that he was at the gas station and purchased beer, at which point his girlfriend, Amber, asked him to drive home. Amber was found to be on drug offender probation for child neglect and battery on LEO. Upon walking towards Deputy Gossett's vehicle I observed Amber reaching in the area next to and behind the driver's seat. Amber inititally denied consent to search her vehicle, and stated no other contraband was present within the vehicle. Due to Amber's furtive movements, the fact that a knife had already been taken off the 10-15's person, and the fact that Amber was on probation for battery on LEO, the vehicle was cleared for weapons prior to allowing Amber to re-enter the vehicle for officer safety purposes. A brown stained glass pipe with marijuana was located around the area Amber was observed reaching and digging through (in between the driver's seat and center console). Further investigation reveled a chrome socket with cannabis residue within the center console. It should be noted that Amber, who is on drug offender probation, with special conditions of no drugs or alcohol, had admitted to have been driving the vehicle just moments ago, was a front passenger, and had access and control of open beer containers as well as cannabis and drug paraphernalia. Amber's boyfriend does has a medical marijuana license. Axon video captured and will be available at evidence.com.

mentioned vehicle due to the traffic infractions.

I made contact with the driver of the vehicle who spontaneously uttered that he does not have a driver's license. The driver provided me with his Florida ID card, which I confirmed his identity as Jacob Scott Baer. Jacob advised that he was driving because his girlfriend, Amber Bruder, was pregnant and not feeling well. Amber was seating in the front passenger seat of the vehicle. There was also an 11-month-old infant in a car seat located behind the front passenger seat. Amber provided the name of the child as Kaya Jolene Baer DOB 6/2/2019. I ran Jacob through NCIC/FCIC and DAVID, which shows Jacob has never been issued a Florida driver's license. Furthermore, NCIC shows that Jacob had a Georgia driver's license, which has been revoked. While I was checking Jacob's driving status, Corporal Gamarra stood by with Jacob for officer safety purposes. Corporal Gamarra observed a blue Busch light can at Jacobs feet where he was sitting. Corporal Gamarra advised the can was cold to the touch when Jacob handed him the beer (alcoholic beverage). Jacob told Corporal Gamarra that he drank a beer over 4 hours ago.


I read Jacob his Miranda rights, and he verbally stated that he would speak to me without a lawyer present. The following is a synopsis of Jacob's post-Miranda statement.

Jacob stated that he knew that he did not have a valid driver's license. Jacob stated that when he lived in Georgia, he was arrested for DUI and lost his license. Jacob stated that he had just paid the last of his DUI fines when Covid-19 occurred, which prevented him from obtaining a new license. Jacob stated that he was only driving because Amber was sick and pregnant.

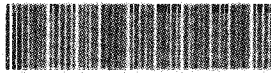
At approximately 1709 hours, I placed Jacob under arrest and escorted him to the prisoner compartment of my patrol vehicle. I then transported Jacob to the Flagler County Detention Facility without incident.

I issued Jacob Ecite Citation # ACGAAHE in reference to Knowingly DWLSR FS 322.34 and citation #ACGAAIE for being in possession of an open container of alcohol as the driver.

I will upload my Axon Body camera into evidence.com in a timely manner.
