On Tuesday 5/17/2011 at approximately 9:09am, I responded to 1000 Cypress Edge Drive (Water Tower Drive), Palm Coast for a reported burglary. Upon my arrival contact was made with Palm Coast Water Department personnel, Cyril "Cy" Parsons (complainant/worker) and James "Jim" Hogan (other/Mgr).

Cy stated that he arrived at approximately 9:00am to conduct his normal duties, when he found a damaged concrete curb stop next to the water tower side door, then observed that the door was damaged. At which time he notified a co-worker to notify law enforcement.

On further investigation, it was determined that entry had been made in to the water tower and that the unknown suspect(s) had already left the scene. Cy then informed me that it appeared that nothing was stolen.

Upon speaking with Jim, he informed me that Utility Services the cities tower servicing company would be responding from Jacksonville within three (3) hours. Jim then advised, that the tower is disconnected from the water main and will remain disconnected until proper testing could be completed. Jim also advised that State Warning Point was apprised of the situation.

A check of the inner and outer perimeter was conducted, a 16 oz. Natural Ice Beer can was located with the inner perimeter, the was photographed and checked for fingerprints/ridge detail also numerous tire track photographs were taken from the outer perimeter.

Fire Flight with Corporal Fink onboard conducted a fly over of the water tower [REDACTED] Two (2) connected fifty (50) foot lengths of green garden hose were also located tied off on an outer metal rail, hanging down from top of the tank and approximately 50 to 60 feet off the ground. Also located was a white St. John's Bay shirt (large) which fell from the top of the water tower (see photographs).

Upon Utility Services arrival, employees Tim McDaniel (other), Garrett Dupree (other) and Allen Lindsey (other) were informed of the situation and what to look for when ascending the tank. Allen then informed me that Garrett inspected the tank, it appears that no one made entry but it was still unsure if anything was placed inside the tank (see photographs). Garrett removed the green garden hose from the tower as requested. On further inspection of the green garden hose a section of gray tape was found with what appeared to be blood, a sample was collected for possible suspect DNA (see photographs).

All photographs have been entered in Aegis, all other items collected have been entered into evidence at the Palm Coast Substation.

The current cost of damages due to the burglary, criminal mischief and loss of services is over and above \$1000.00 dollars.
