Client continues to remain complete with all medication management as well as continues to exhibit effective independent living skills and activities of daily living. He owners own car and is able to complete all car maintenance and insurance payments independently. Strengths:

Mr. Wothers handles all physical and mental health appointments as well as medication management, including refills of medications, with minimal follow up from case management, He is redirectable and is able to recognize his symptoms and look for help. Mr. Wothers currently received psychiatric services from both Passageway and the U.S.. Department of Veteran Affairs in Miami, FL. He currently meets with his psychiatrist at Passageway on a monthly basis and his VA psychiatrist every three months or on an as needed basis. Mr. Wothers must continue to take all medications as prescribed (see list bellow) and continue to meet with a psychiatrist on a regular basis at a VA clinic located up north (1198 S. Governors Avenue, Sulte 201 Double DE 19901). This new clinic is located near his mother's current home and is located approximately 25 minutes from where Mr. Wothers future home will be located (Goldsboro, Marvland.) Mr. Wothers will continue to manage his medications and medication and medication is independently.

Mr. Wothers has remained abstinent from all lilicit substances and alcohol for the last elevel years. He stopped attending meeting roughly three years ago. He is aware of the locations of meeting in Dover if needed. Mr. Wothers must continue to remain abstinent
