SENTENCING ORDER

This Matter came before this Court pursuant to the State's request for a sentencing order. Having had a sentencing hearing on September 27, 2010, having reviewed the file, and heard argument of the parties, the Court finds the following:

In December 2008, two criminal charges were filed against Defendant for Cruelty to Animals and Unlawful Abandonment or Confinement of Animals arising out of her failure to adequately care for the hundreds of pigs on her property commonly referred to as the Pig Tales Sanctuary. On March 26, 2009, Defendant pled to both charges as part of a deferred prosecution agreement. The DPA required that she bring her property into compliance with the conditions in the herd plan and the quarantine on her property.

Defendant has failed to comply with the conditions of the deferred prosecution agreement. Consequently, this case is back before this Court for sentencing.

Testimony before this Court has established that Defendant continues to be in violation of the applicable state laws regarding the animals on the property known as Pig Tales Sanctuary and appears unable to bring the property or animals into compliance with the herd plan and quarantine that govern the animals on her property. It further appears that Defendant's inability to comply poses a threat to welfare of the animals on her

property, to the surrounding animal populations, and possibly the human population in the area.

It is therefore ORDERED and ADJUDGED that Defendant is hereby placed on twelve (12) months administrative probation with the following conditions:

1. Defendant is hereby prohibited from having custody, supervision, possession, or responsibility for the care of the pigs currently on the property known as Pig Tales Sanctuary, and said pigs are hereby forfeited.
2. Flagler County is hereby authorized to take immediate custody of quarantined swine herd at Pig Tales Sanctuary and assume responsibility for the care of said animals and to coordinate said care for the animals with the appropriate state and federal authorities;
3. Defendant is hereby prohibited from possessing any pigs during the 12 months of her probation.
